MIT-WPU, Berlin biz school ties up for student, faculty exchanges

MIT World Peace University (MIT-WPU), Pune, and the Berlin School of Business and Innovation (BSBI), Germany, will collaborate on student and faculty exchanges, joint research and academic programmes following an agreement between the two institutions.

The partnership between MIT-WPU's Ram Charan School of Business and BSBI aims to create opportunities for international mobility, research collaboration and technology-driven learning initiatives. "MIT-WPU and the Berlin School of Business and Innovation are coming together through this MoU to build bridges that will benefit the entire academic community," said Executive President, MIT-WPU, Dr Rahul Karad.

The Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) was signed by Dr Karad and Prof Dr Kyriakos Kouveliotis, Provost, BSBI and Chief Academic Officer, Global University Systems,

Germany, in the presence of Prof Shiv Tripathi, Dean, Faculty of Economics and Business Administration, BSBI, and Ganesh Pokale, Registrar, MIT-WPU.

"The partnership will focus on student and faculty exchanges, research collaboration and reciprocal visits between the institutions," said Kouveliotis.

While addressing MIT-WPU faculty members, Kouveliotis spoke about the role of Artificial Intelligence (AI) in education and said institutions should use the technology to improve learning outcomes.

Kouveliotis also spoke about international student mobility and said a

large proportion of students across five German institutions he is associated with are from India. He said while overseas education provides valuable exposure, Indian institutions should develop global learning environments to retain talent.

He also referred to MIT-WPU's Life Transformation Centre and its focus on continuous learning and skill development.

The collaboration will also cover areas such as research, innovation and academic exchange, with both institutions working towards developing programmes focused on emerging sectors including healthcare innovation.

MIT-WPU signs strategic MoU with Berlin business school

PUNE: MIT World Peace University (MIT-WPU), Pune, has signed a strategic Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with the Berlin School of Business and Innovation (BSBI), Germany, to strengthen collaboration in higher education through academic exchanges, joint research, faculty and student mobility, and technology-driven learning initiatives.

The agreement was signed by Hon. Dr. Rahul V. Karad, Executive President, MIT-WPU, and Prof. Dr. Kyriakos Kouveliotis, Provost of BSBI and Chief Academic Officer, Global University Systems, Germany, in the presence of Prof. Shiv Tripathi, Dean, Faculty of Economics and Business Administration, BSBI, and Ganesh Pokale, Registrar, MIT-WPU.

The partnership aims to create opportunities for collaborative research, international exposure for students and faculty, cultural exchange, and innovation-led education while equipping graduates with



globally relevant skills.

Dr. Rahul Karad said the collaboration would build lasting academic bridges between the two institutions and benefit the wider education community by fostering international cooperation and knowledge sharing.

Prof. Kouveliotis described the MoU as the beginning of a new chapter in Indo-European educational relations. He said both institutions would immediately initiate student and faculty exchange programmes, strengthen joint research efforts, and organise reciprocal academic visits to enrich learning experiences.

Addressing MIT-WPU faculty members, Kouveliotis stressed the responsible integration of Artificial Intelligence in higher education.

He said AI should be used to automate administrative tasks such as formatting and syllabus updates, enabling educators to devote more time to mentoring students and meaningful academic engagement. Institutions adopting AI in this manner, he said, would enhance educational quality rather than merely reduce operational costs.

He also highlighted global student mobility, noting that nearly 70 per cent of students across five German institutions under his academic leadership, are from India. While recognising the benefits of overseas education, he encouraged Indian universities to create world-class opportunities domestically to help curb long-term brain drain.

लखनऊ । एमआईटी वर्ल्ड पीस यूनिवर्सिटी ने वैश्व उच्च शिक्षा को बढ़ावा देने की अपनी साझा प्रतिबद्धता को मजबूत करते हुए बर्लिन स्कूल ऑफ बिजनेस एंड इनोवेशन, जर्मनी के साथ एक रणनीतिक समझौता ज्ञापन पर आधिकारिक तौर पर हस्ताक्षर किए। इस ऐतिहासिक समझौते पर एमआईटी-डब्ल्यूपीयू पुणे के कार्यकारी अध्यक्ष माननीय डॉ. राहुल वी. कराड और बीएसबीआई स्कूल ऑफ बिजनेस एंड इनोवेशन (बीएसबीआई, बर्लिन) के प्रोफेसर और ग्लोबल निवेश सिस्टम्स, जर्मनी के मुख्य शैक्षणिक अधिकारी प्रो. डॉ. काइरियाकोस कौवेलियोटिस ने हस्ताक्षर किए। इस अवसर पर बीएसबीआई बर्लिन के इकोनॉमिक्स एंड बिजनेस एडमिनिस्ट्रेशन फैकल्टी के डीन प्रो. शिव त्रिपाठी और एमआईटी-डब्ल्यूपीयू पुणे के रजिस्ट्रार गणेश पोक्ले भी उपस्थित थे। यह सहयोग शैक्षणिक और सांस्कृतिक आदान-प्रदान, संयुक्त अनुसंधान और



अंतराष्ट्रीय गतिशीलता को बढ़ावा देगा, साथ ही वैश्व दक्षताओं वाले स्नातकों को तैयार करने के लिए प्रौद्योगिकी-संचालित शिक्षण और नवाचार के अवसर पैदा करेगा। एमआईटी-डब्ल्यूपीयू पुणे के रजिस्ट्रार श्री गणेश पोक्ले ने इस गठबंधन को लेकर अत्यधिक आशावाद व्यक्त करते हुए कहा कि एमआईटी-डब्ल्यूपीयू और बर्लिन स्कूल ऑफ बिजनेस एंड इनोवेशन इस समझौता ज्ञापन के माध्यम से एक ऐसा सेतु बनाने के लिए एक साथ आ रहे हैं

जिससे पूरे शैक्षणिक समुदाय को लाभ होगा। इसी भावना को दोहराते हुए प्रो. डॉ. काइरियाकोस कौवेलियोटिस ने कहा कि यह साझेदारी भारत-यूरोपीय शैक्षणिक संबंधों में एक नए अध्याय की शुरुआत है। उन्होंने इस बात पर जोर दिया कि दोनों संस्थान तुरंत सक्रिय छात्र और संकाय आदान-प्रदान शुरू करेंगे, साझा अनुसंधान संबंधों को मजबूत करेंगे और सीखने के अनुभव को समृद्ध करने के लिए पारस्परिक द्विपक्षीय दौरों का समन्वय करेंगे। एमआईटी-डब्ल्यूपीयू के संकाय को

संबोधित करते हुए प्रो. डॉ. कौवेलियोटिस ने वैश्व शिक्षा के भविष्य के लिए एक परिवर्तनकारी दृष्टिकोण रेखांकित किया, जिसमें जिम्मेदारी से आर्टिफिशियल इंटेलिजेंस को एकीकृत करने की आवश्यकता पर प्रकाश डाला गया। उन्होंने समझाया कि फॉर्मेटिंग और सिलेबस अपडेट जैसे भारी प्रशासनिक कार्यों को स्वचालित करके शिक्षक छात्रों की गहरी सलाह (मेंटरिंग) और प्रामाणिक संवाद पर ध्यान केंद्रित करने के लिए मूल्यवान समय निकाल सकते हैं। उन्होंने दृढ़ता से कहा कि इस तरह से एआई को अपनाने वाले संस्थान संसाधनों में कटौती करने या संकाय पदों को कम करने के उद्देश्य से सस्ते मॉडल बनाने के बजाय अधिक समृद्ध, उच्च मूल्य वाले शैक्षणिक अनुभव पैदा करेंगे। प्रो. डॉ. कौवेलियोटिस ने छात्र गतिशीलता के वैश्विक रुझान पर भी बात की और उल्लेख किया कि पांच जर्मन संस्थानों में उनके लगभग 70% छात्र भारत से हैं।
