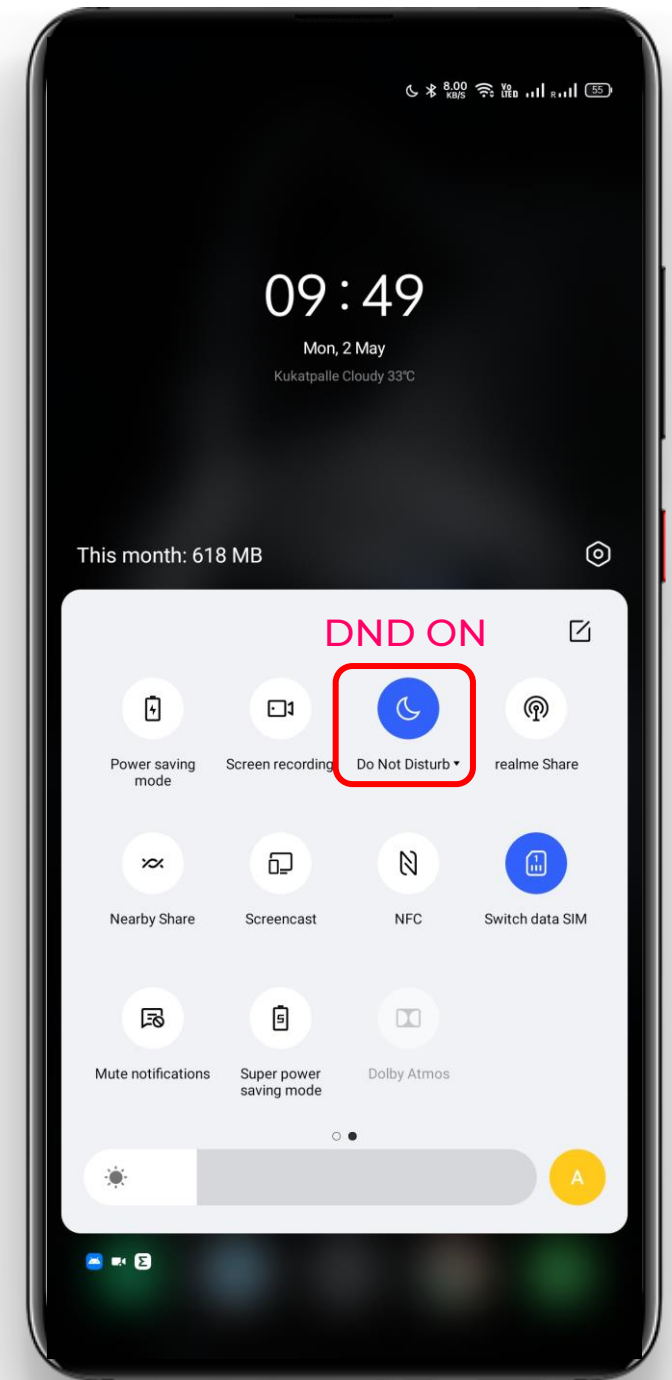
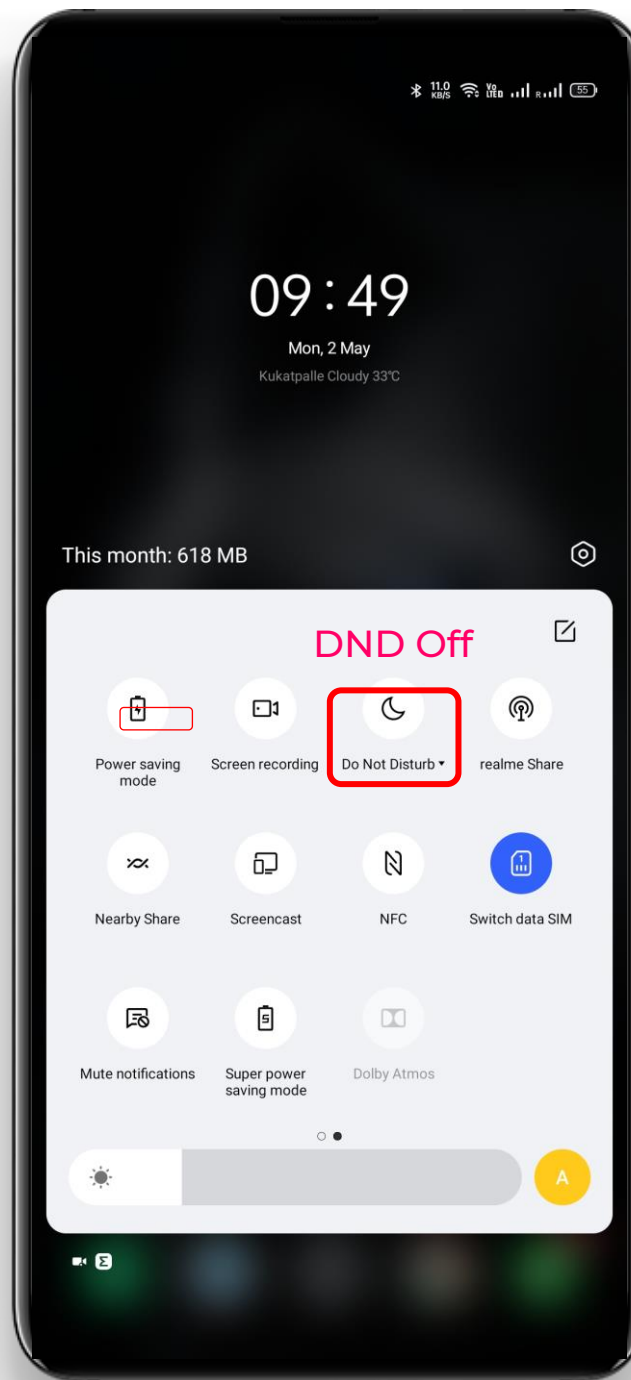

## Turning DND Mode

Ensure that **Do Not Disturb** mode is turned on before starting the exam, otherwise you might get blocked during the exam if anything pop up over the exam screen.



## Step 01

Visit the **Login Page** in a supported browser according to your operating system

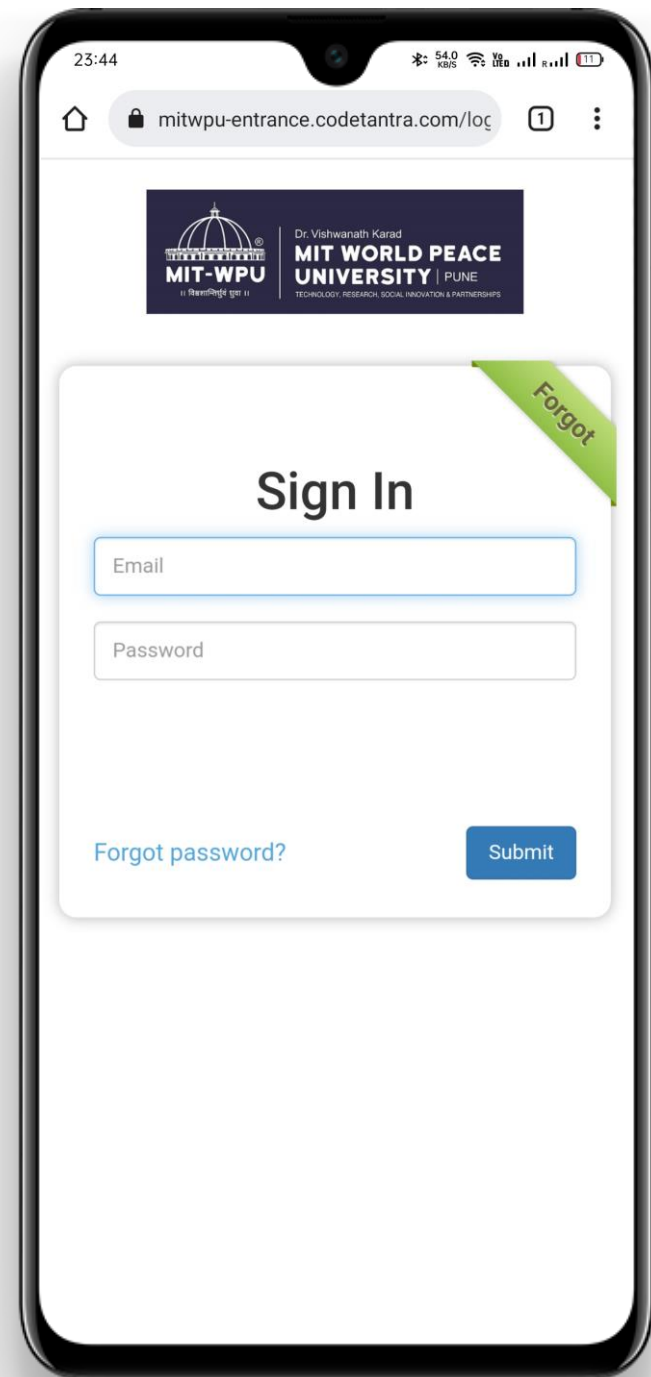



Enter your **email-id** and **password** in the respective box and then click on **Submit**.

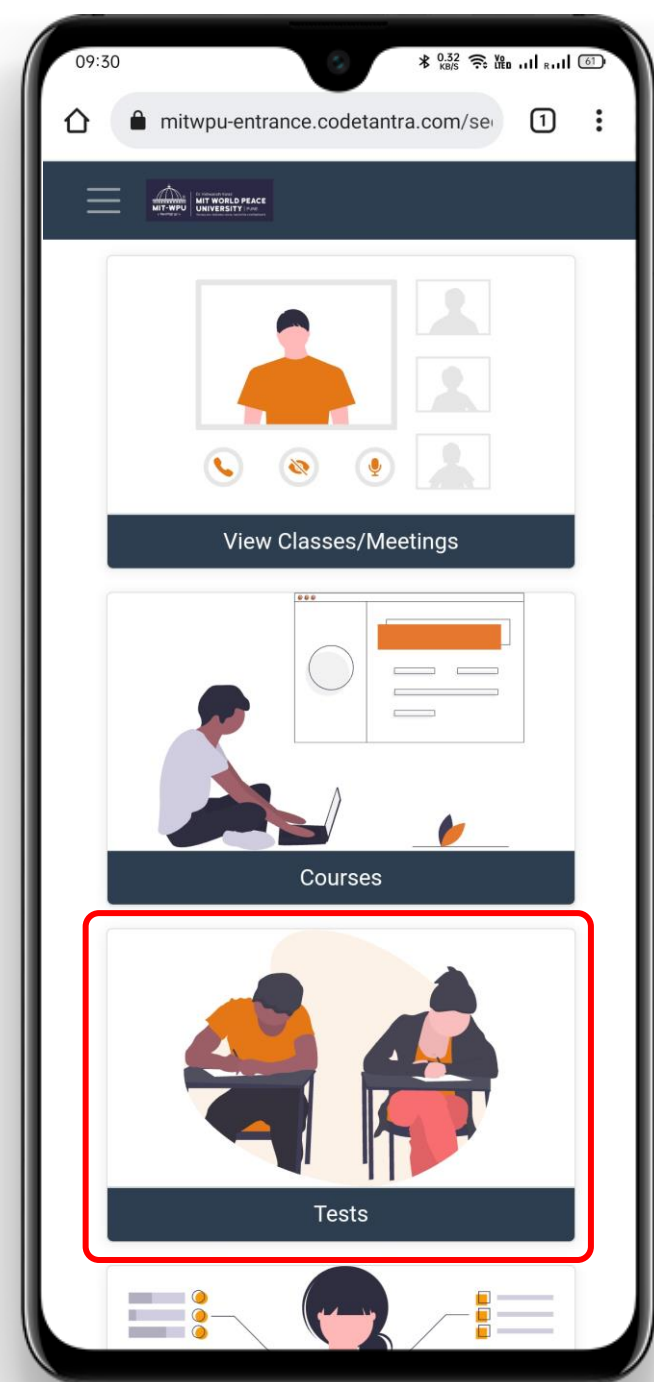

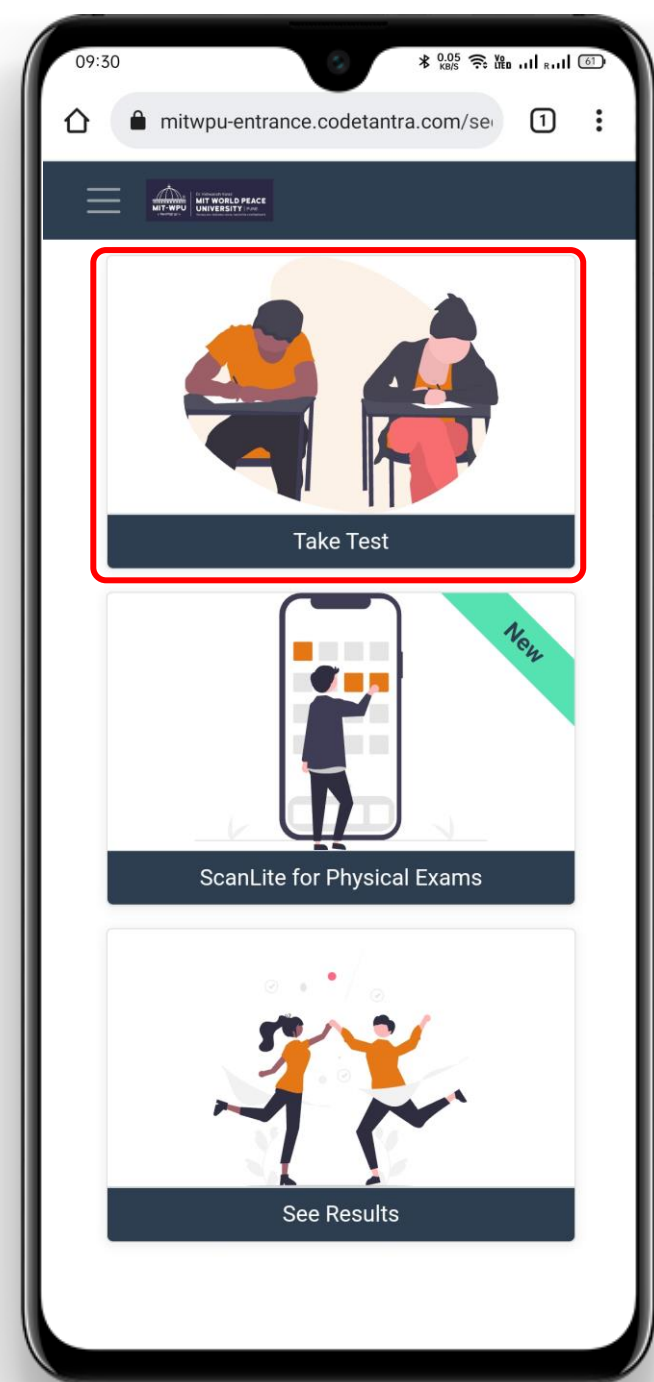
## Step 03

Click on **Tests** card available on the home page



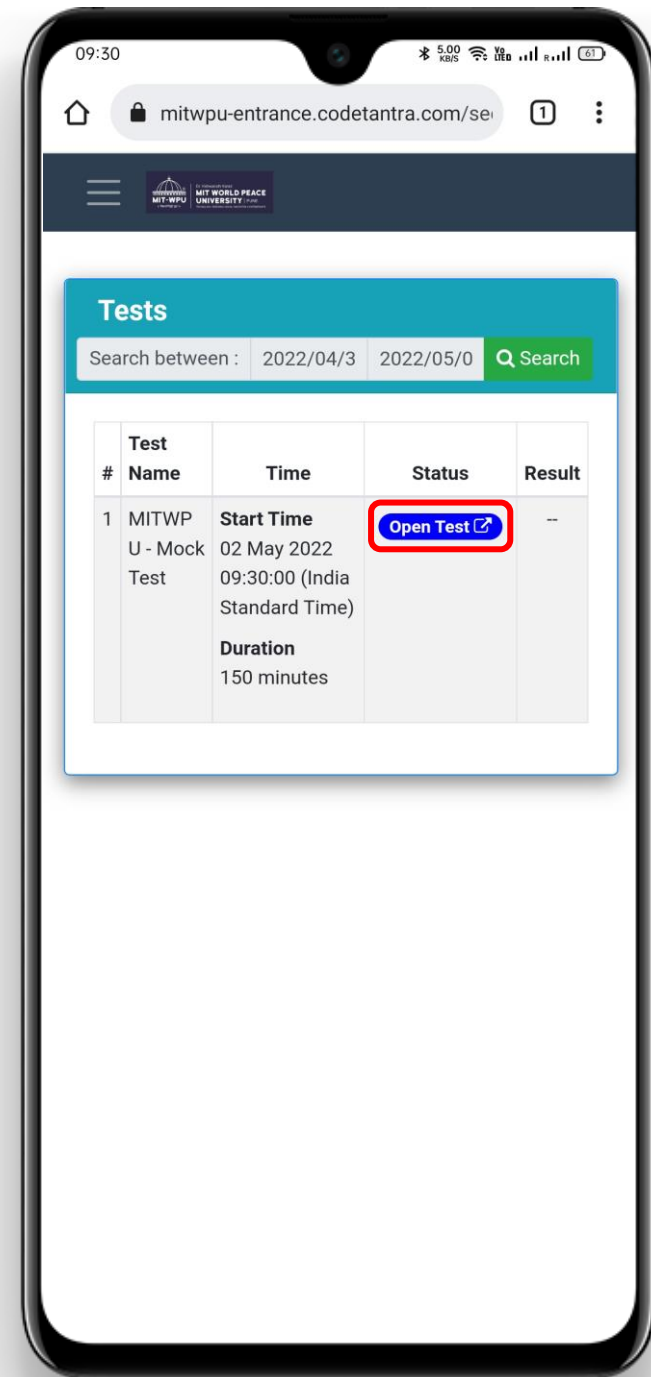
## Step 04

Select **Open Test** button against your applicable test.

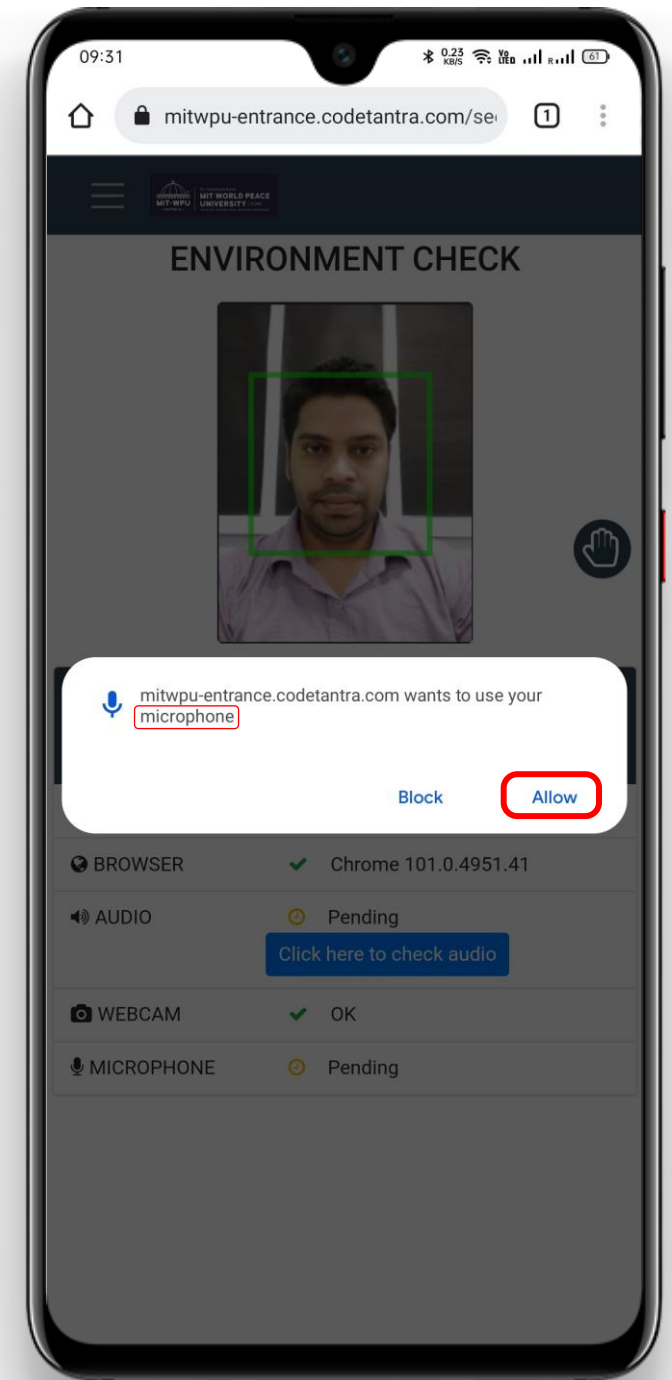
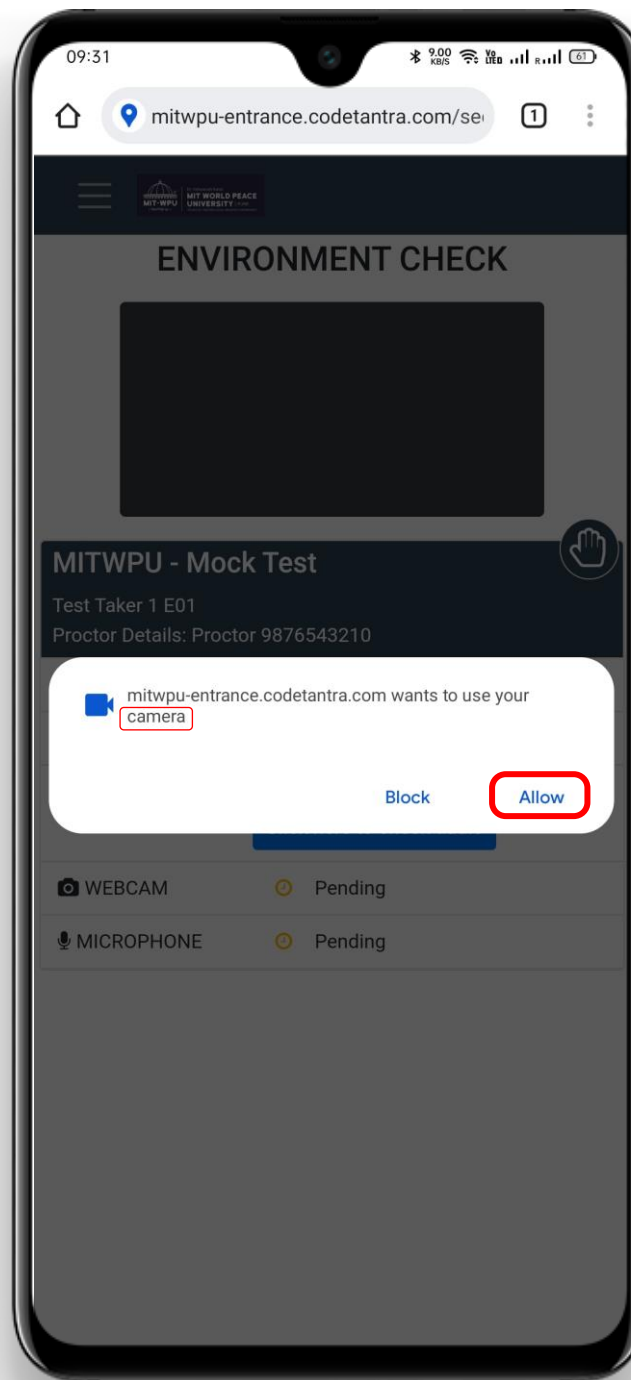




## Step 06

Click on all the **Allow** buttons that appear in succession on this page to allow the browser to use your **camera** and **microphone**.

You might be asked for the permission for Location access, click on Allow, if it appears.

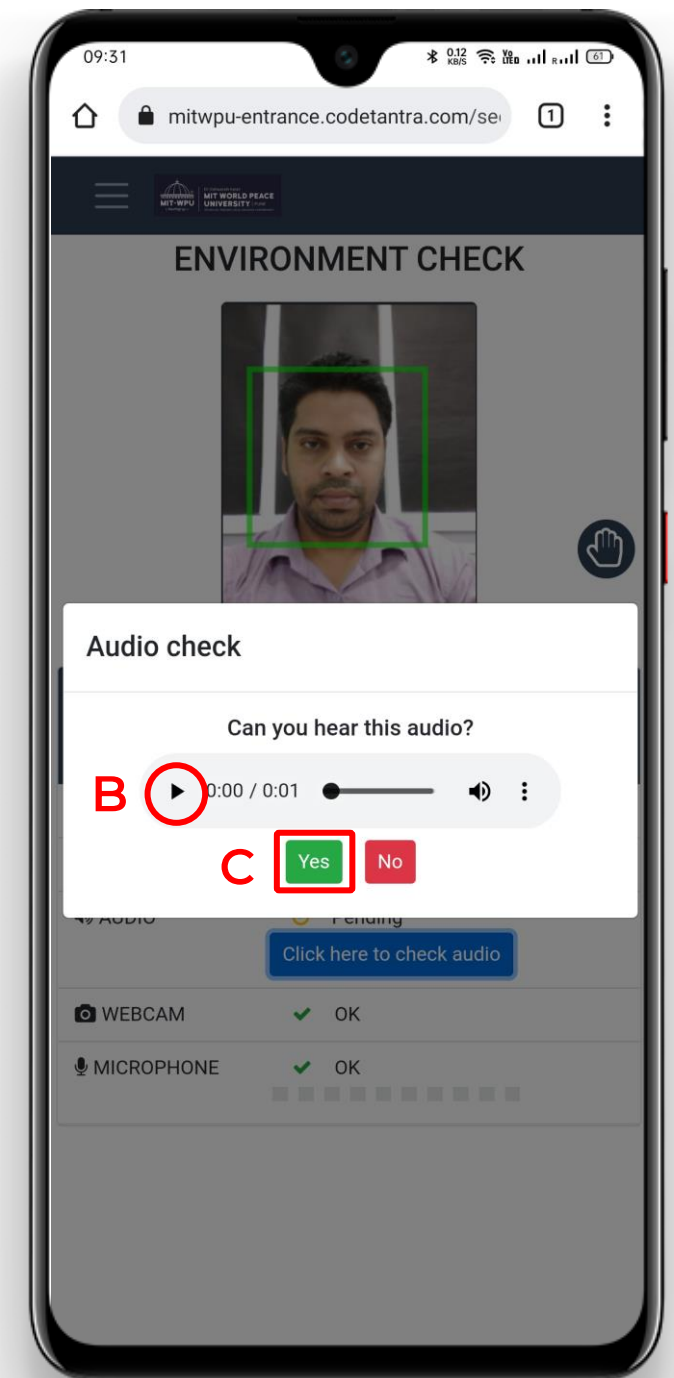
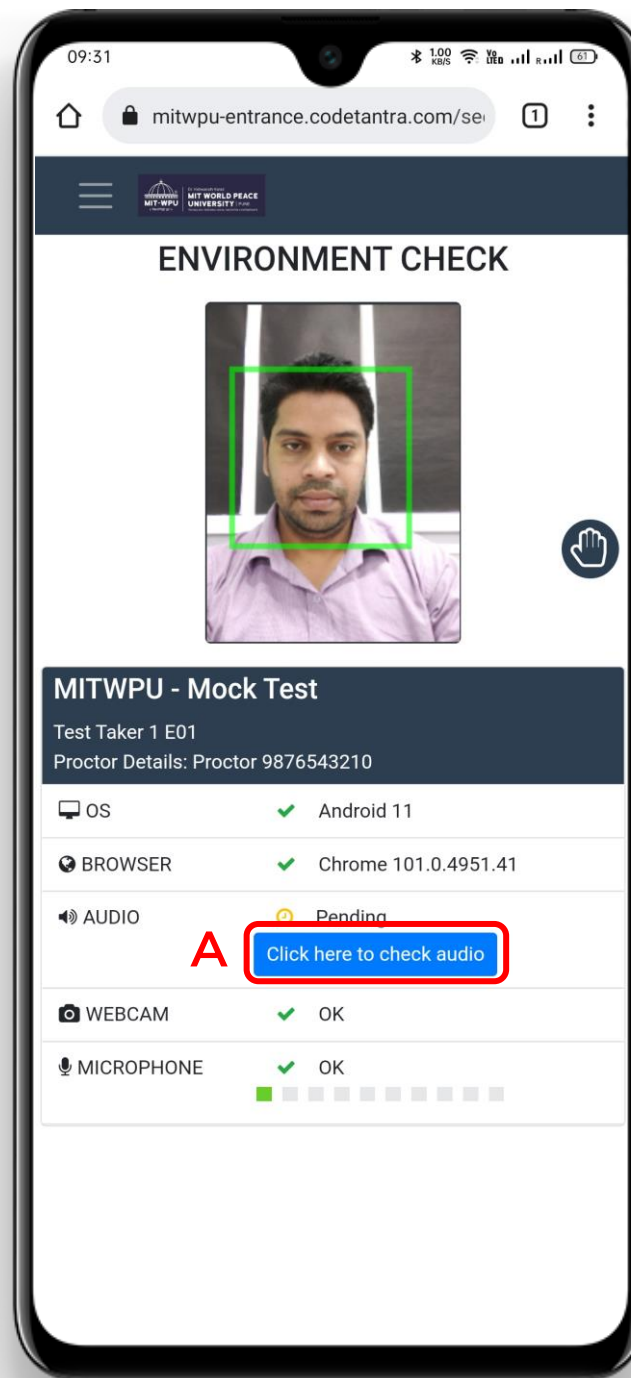


## Step 07

Click on (A) Click here to check audio, click on (B) Play button and then click on (C) Yes.

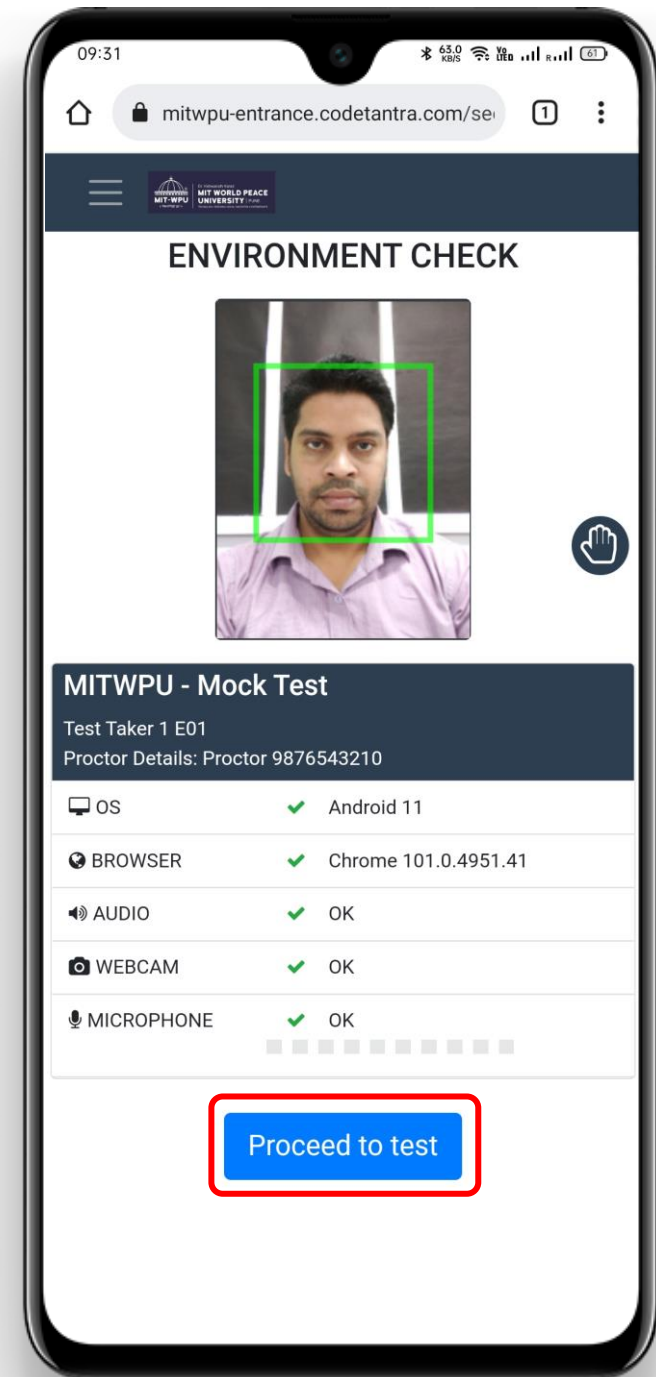
### Important Note:

If you are not able to listen after clicking on Play button (Step B), then ensure that volume of your device is set to maximum and then try again by refreshing the page.

Click on **Proceed to test** button to go to the next step.

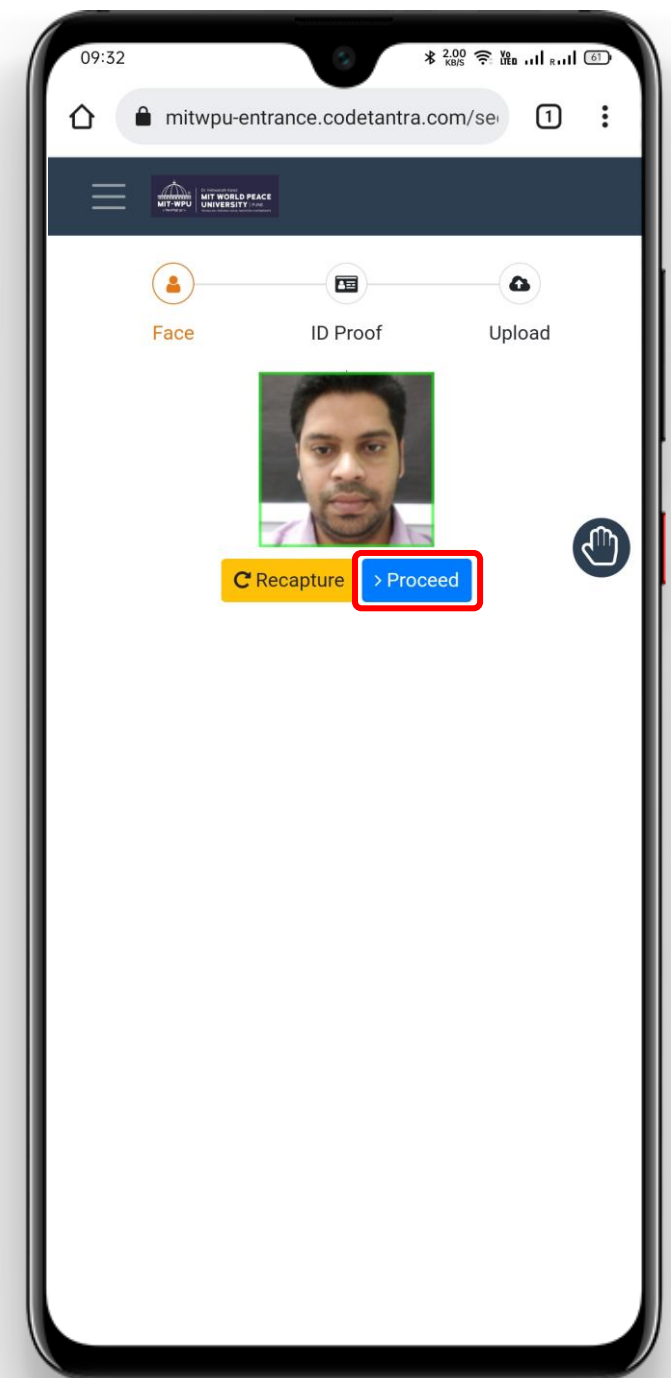
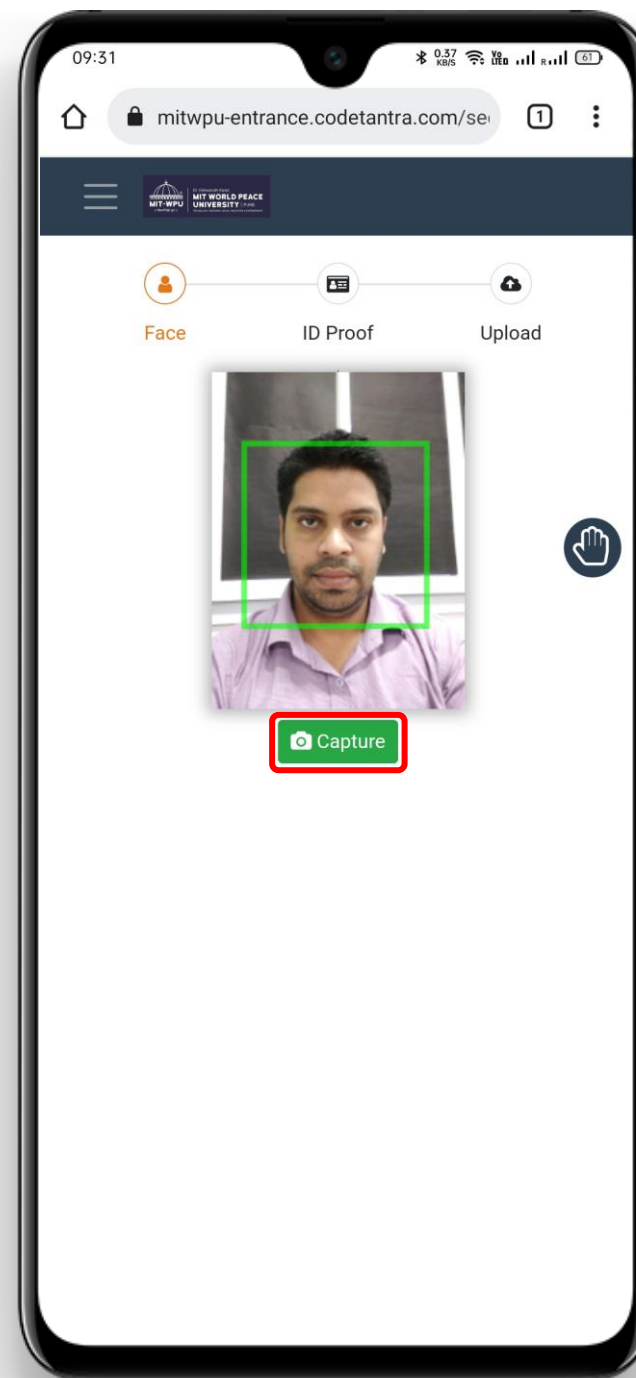


## Step 09

Ensure that your face is visible in the picture frame and then click on **Capture** button to capture your face.

### Important Note:

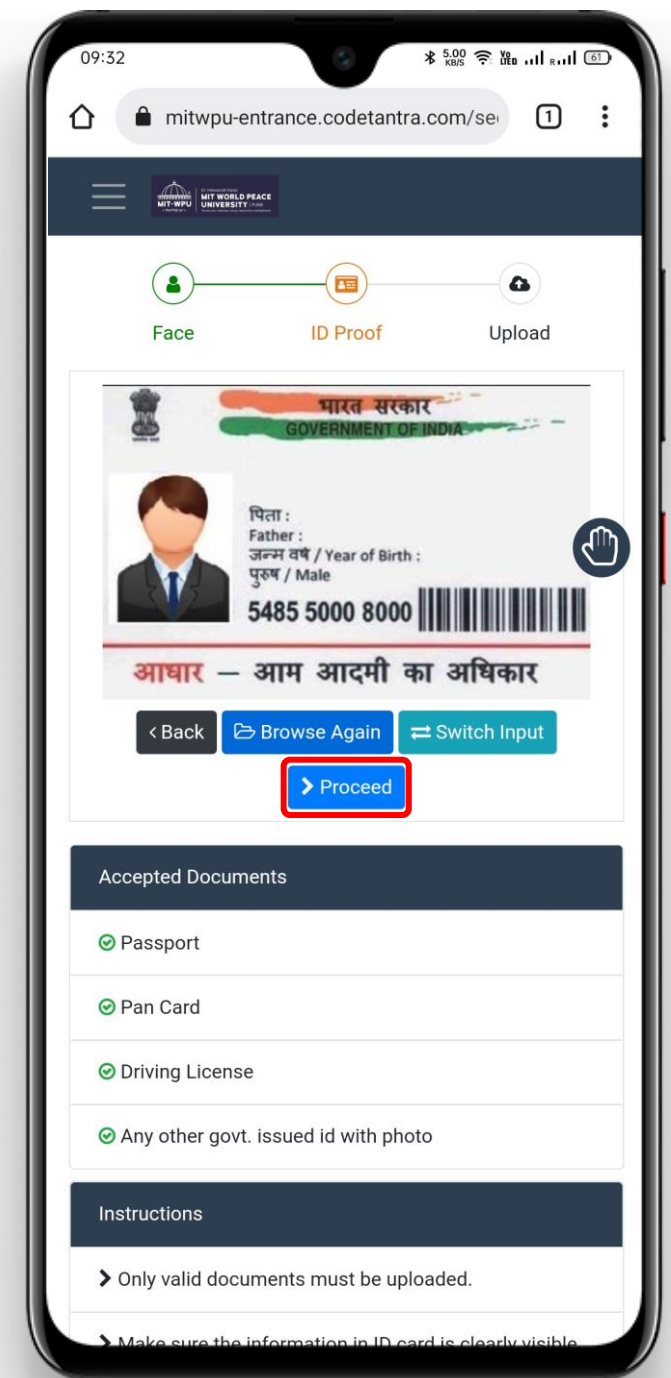
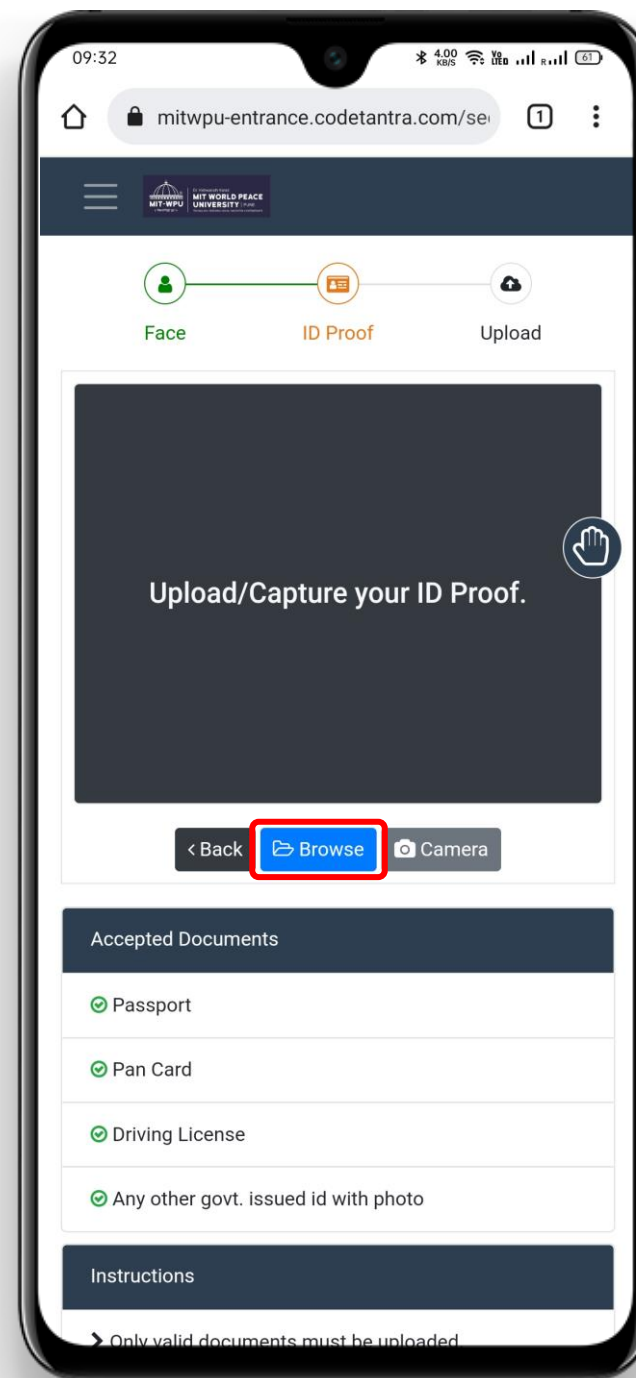
If your face is captured properly then click on **Proceed** otherwise click on **Recapture** to recapture your face.



## Step 10

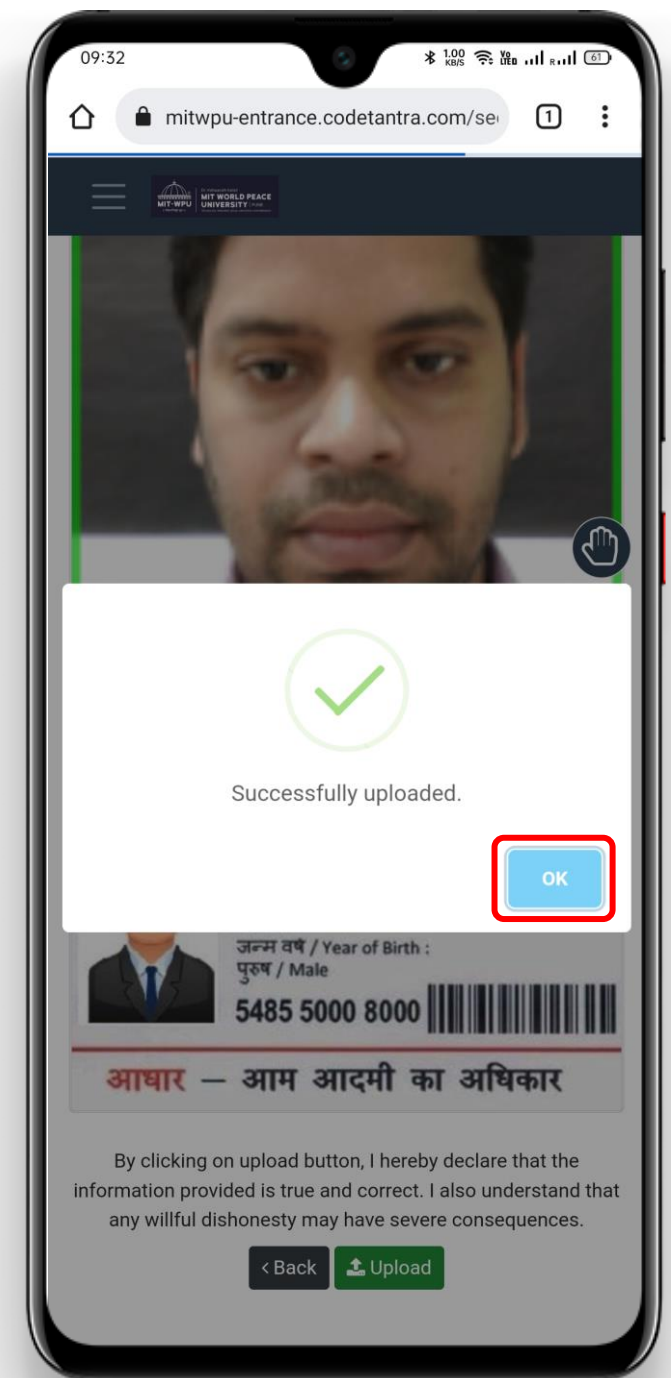
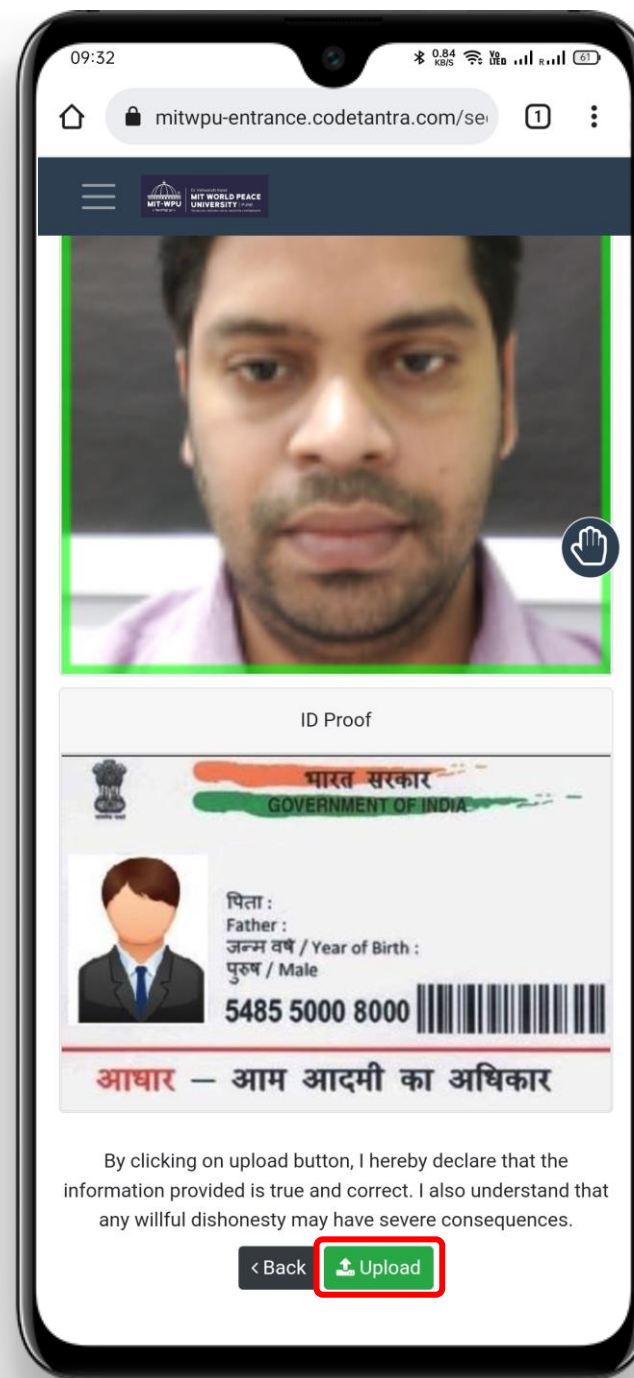
Click on **Browse** button and select the digital copy of your ID card stored in your device.

Alternatively, you can use **Camera** button to capture the image of your physical ID card.



## Step 11

Click on **Upload** button to upload your captured Face and ID card images.



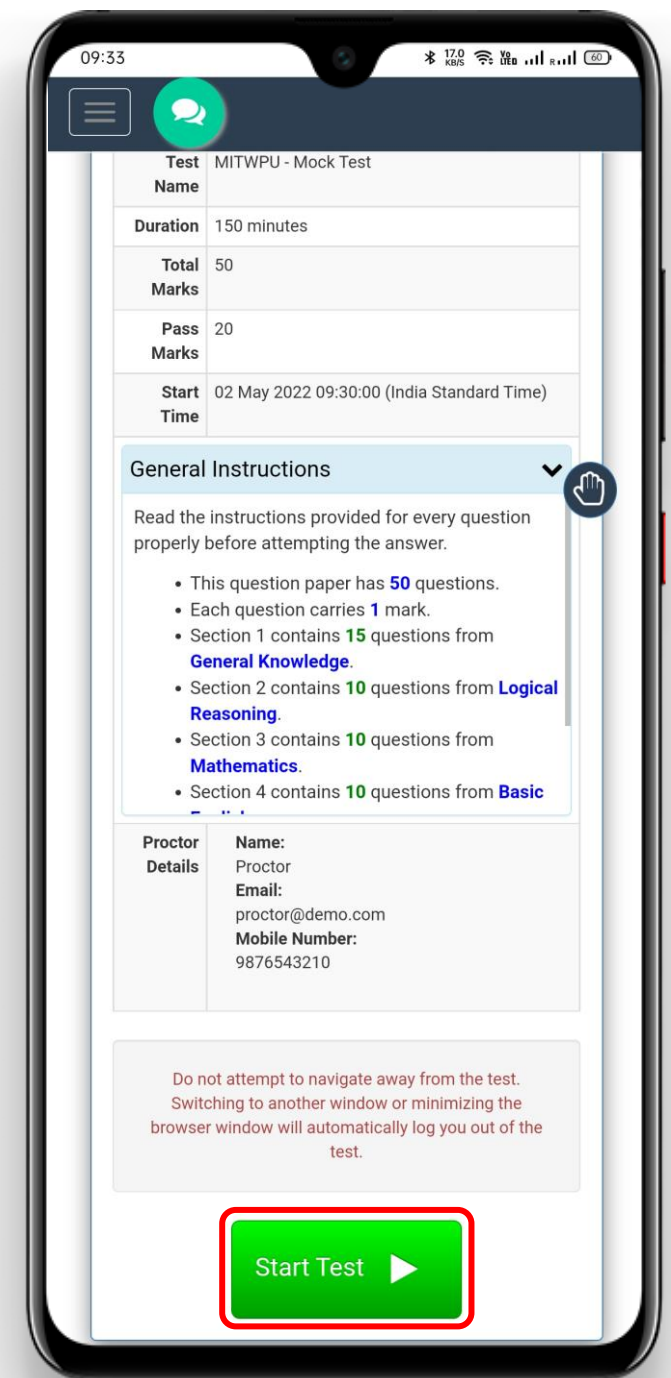
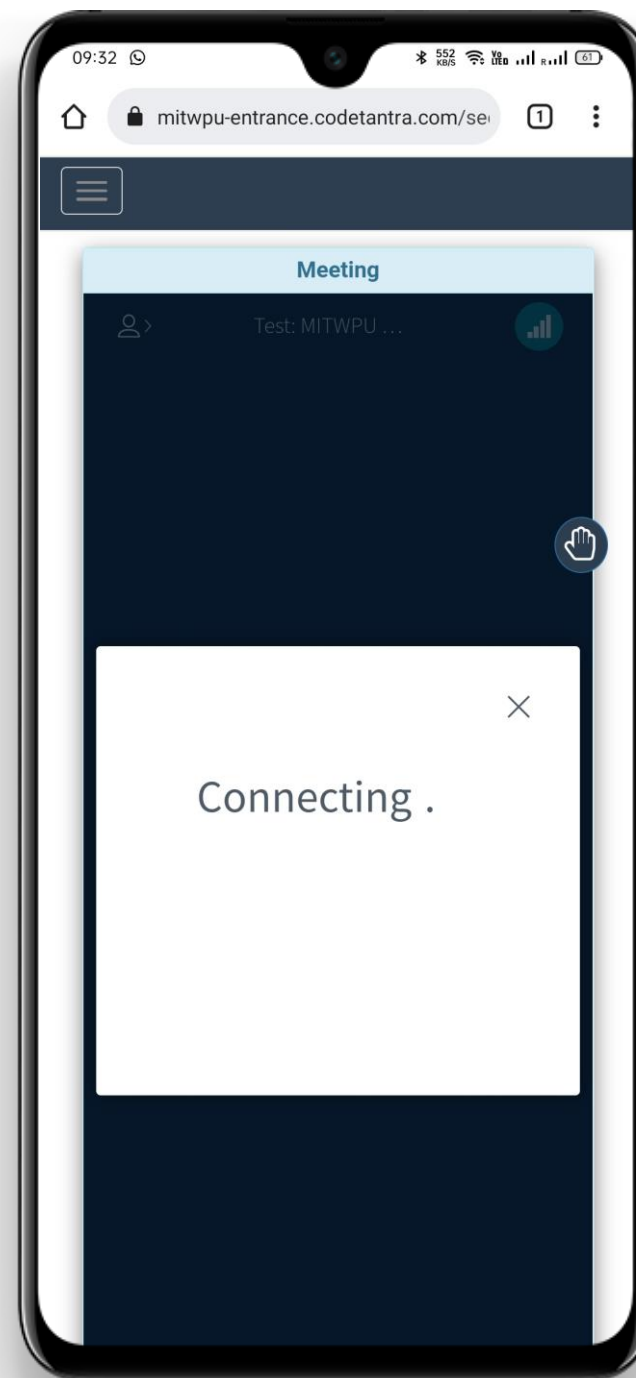


## Step 12

Wait on this page for few seconds until you get the **Start Test** option. Once you get the Start Test option, click on it to start the test.

### Important Note:

If you have completed the previous steps before the actual start time of the test, then in place of Start Test button you might get a reverse timer indicating you to wait before you can get the Start Test button.



## Answering Questions

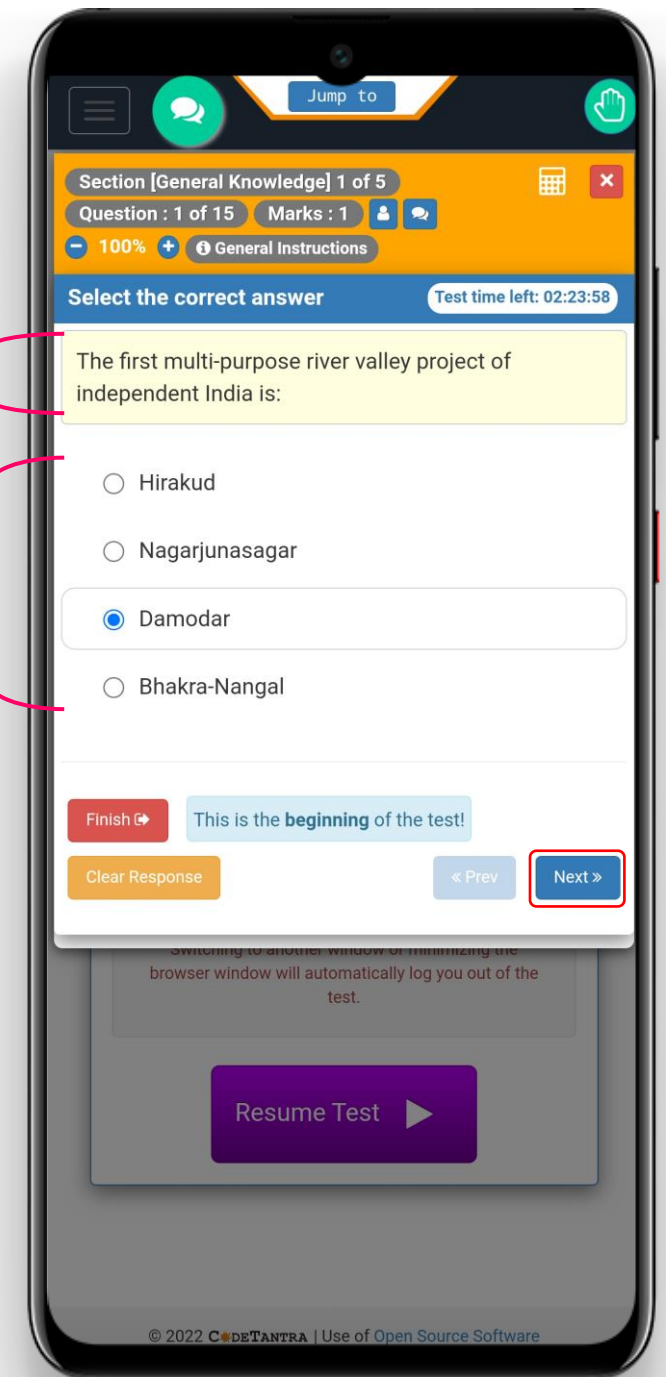
Select the correct option by clicking on it and then click on the Next button to save your response.

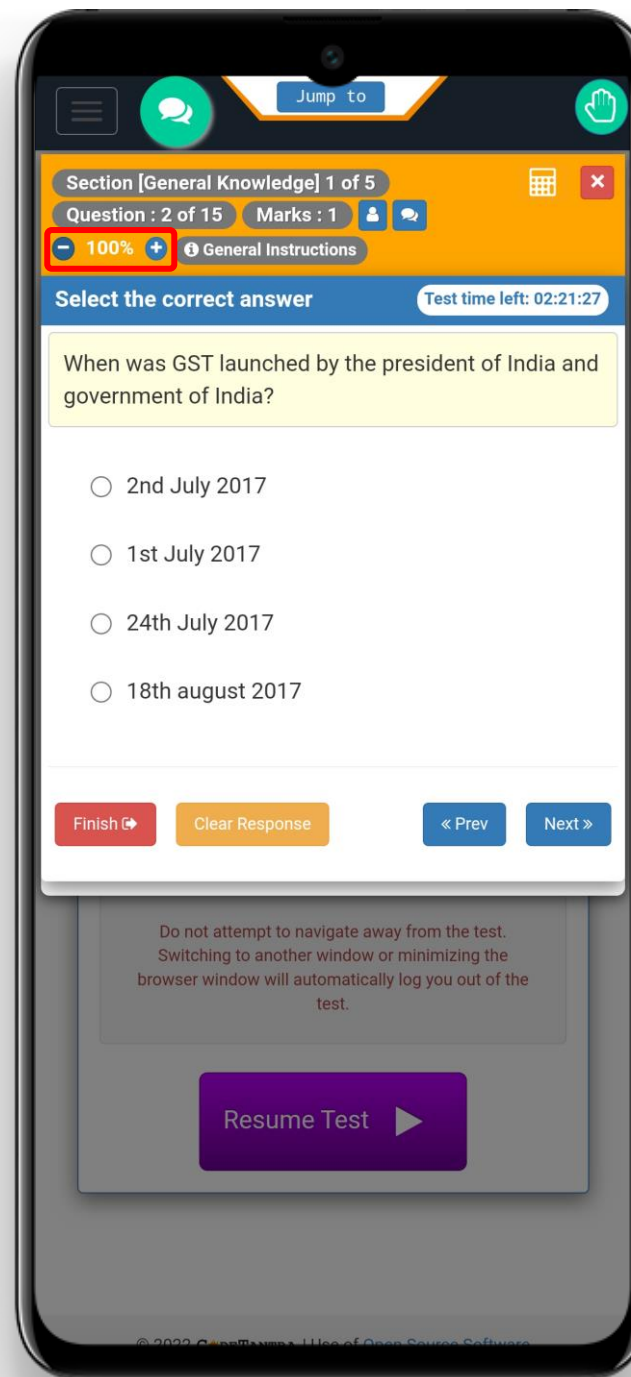

## Resizing Questions and Options Texts

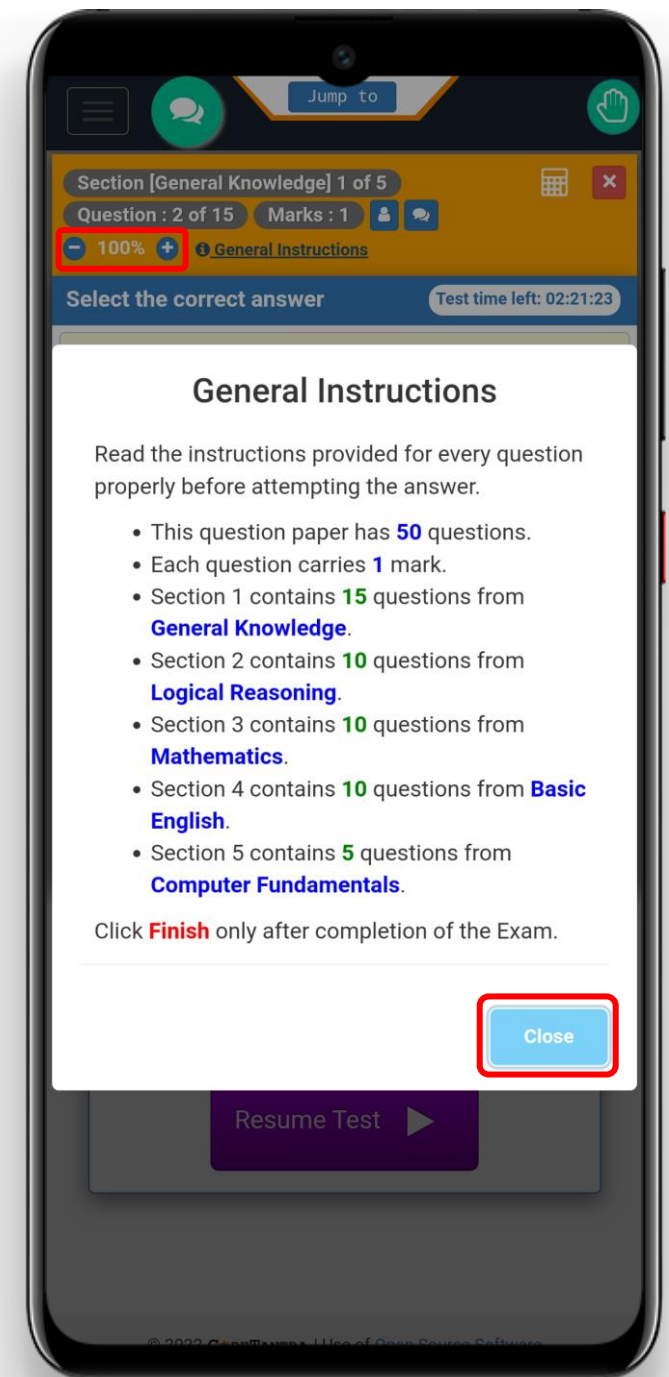
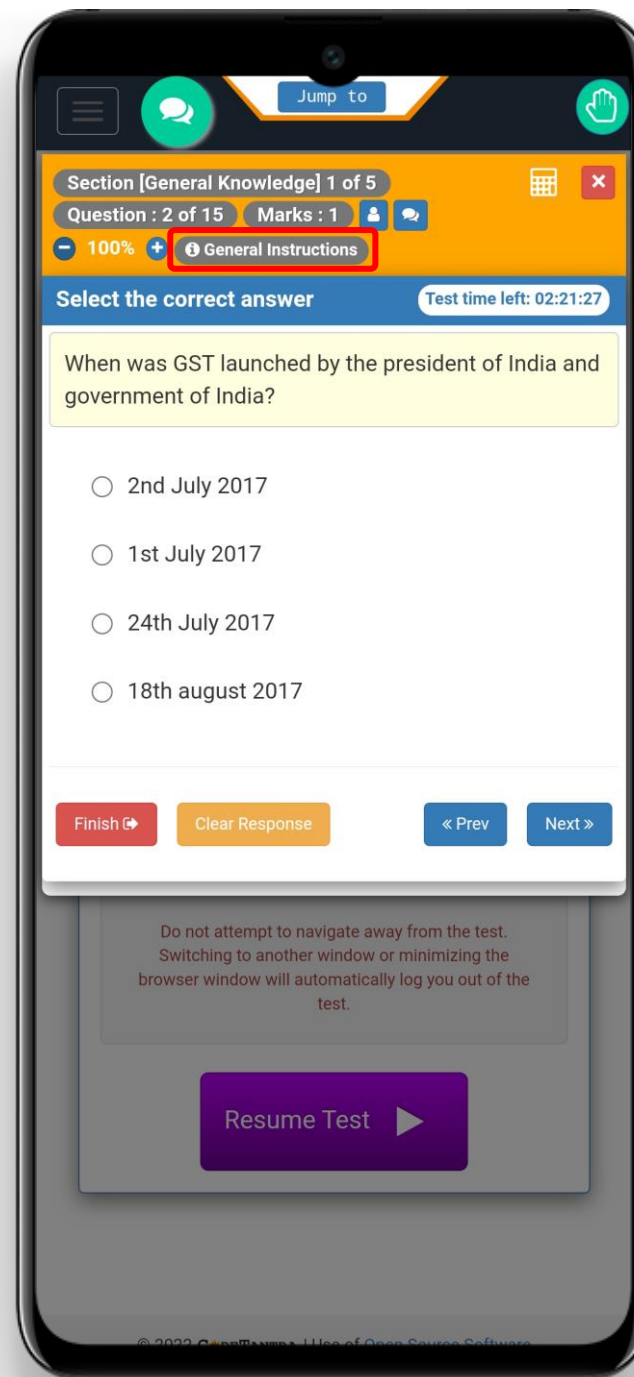
You can use **+** button to increase the question and options text size. Similarly, you can use **-** button to decrease the question and options text size.



## Accessing General Instructions

You can click on **General Instructions** button to access the general instructions of the test.

Click on Close button once you are done viewing the general instructions.

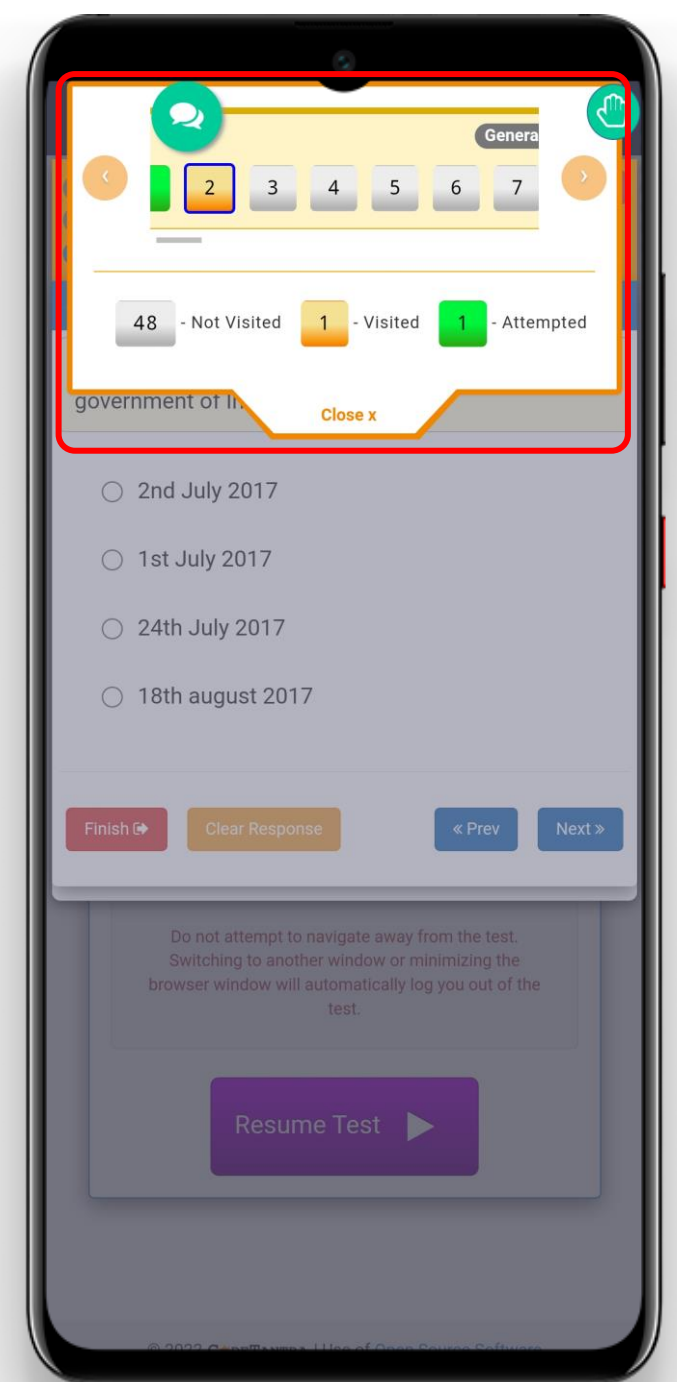
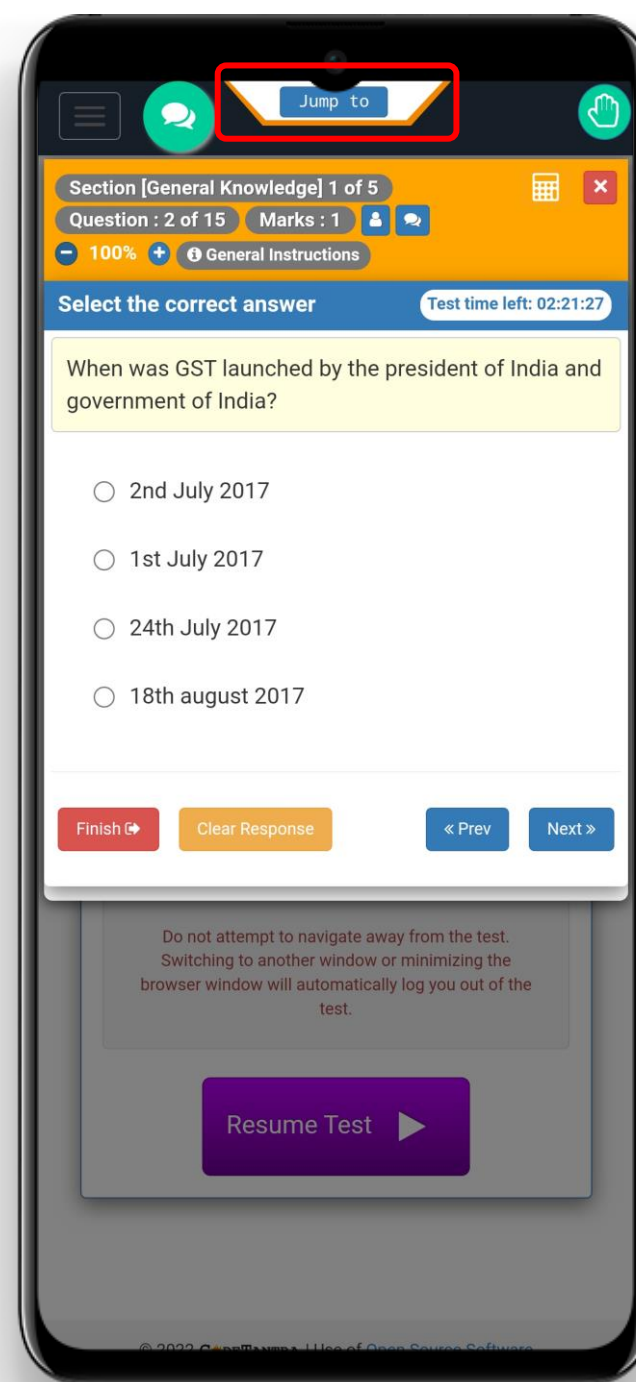


## Accessing Jump to panel

You can click on **Jump to** button to navigate from the current question to any question of the test.

Scroll towards left or right in the Jump to panel to access other sections and their respective questions.

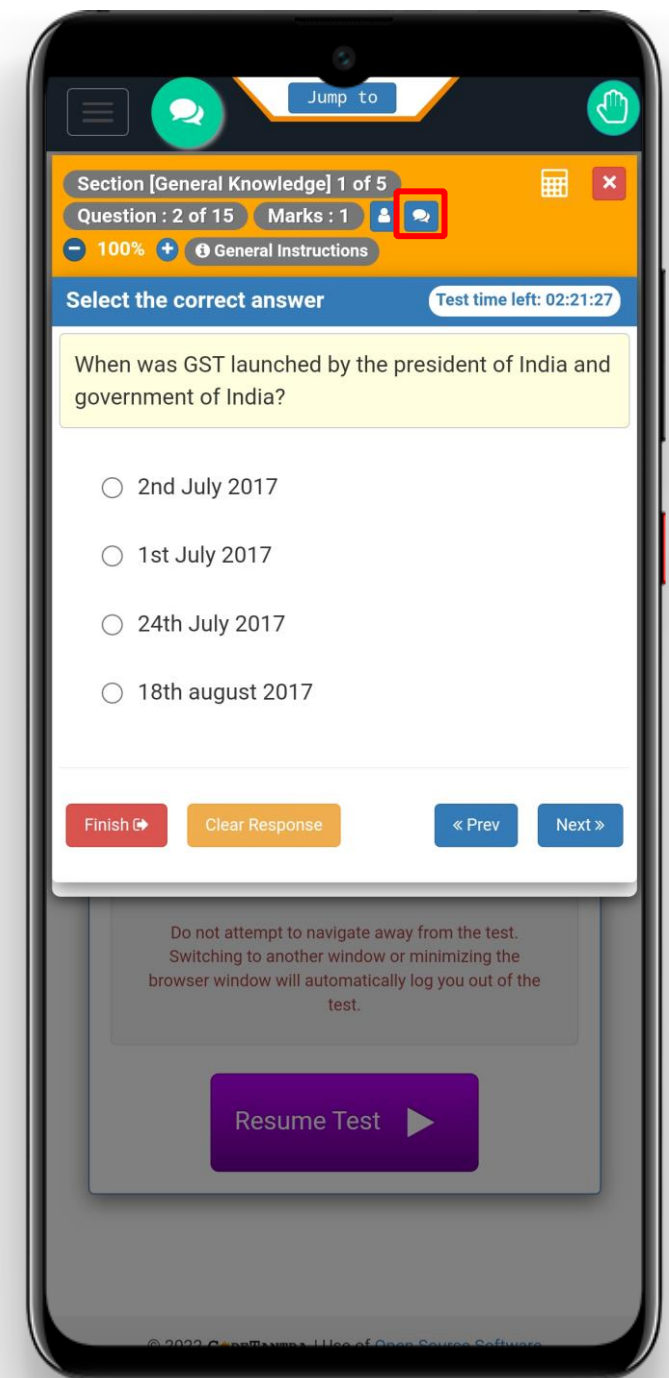
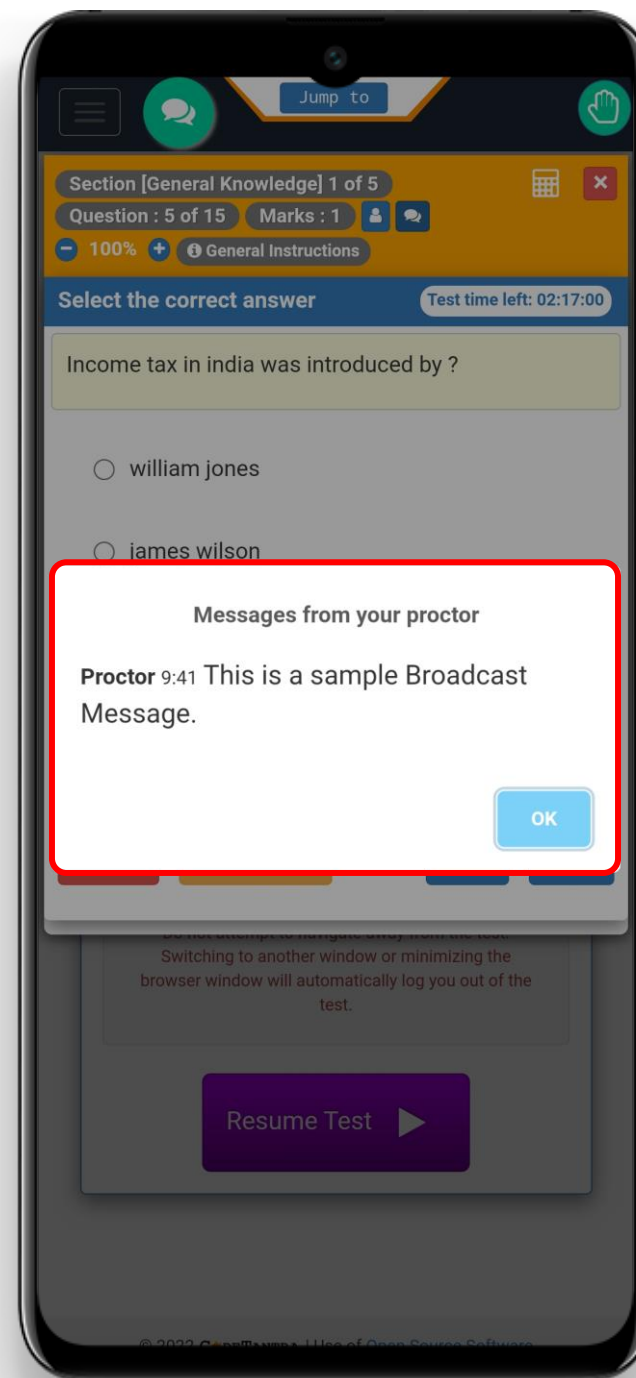
Click on any question number to move to that question.



## Accessing Broadcasted Message

During the exam, you might get **broadcasted** message from your proctor. Read the message and click on **OK** button to make it disappear.

You can access all the broadcasted message at once by clicking on the small blue **message icon**.



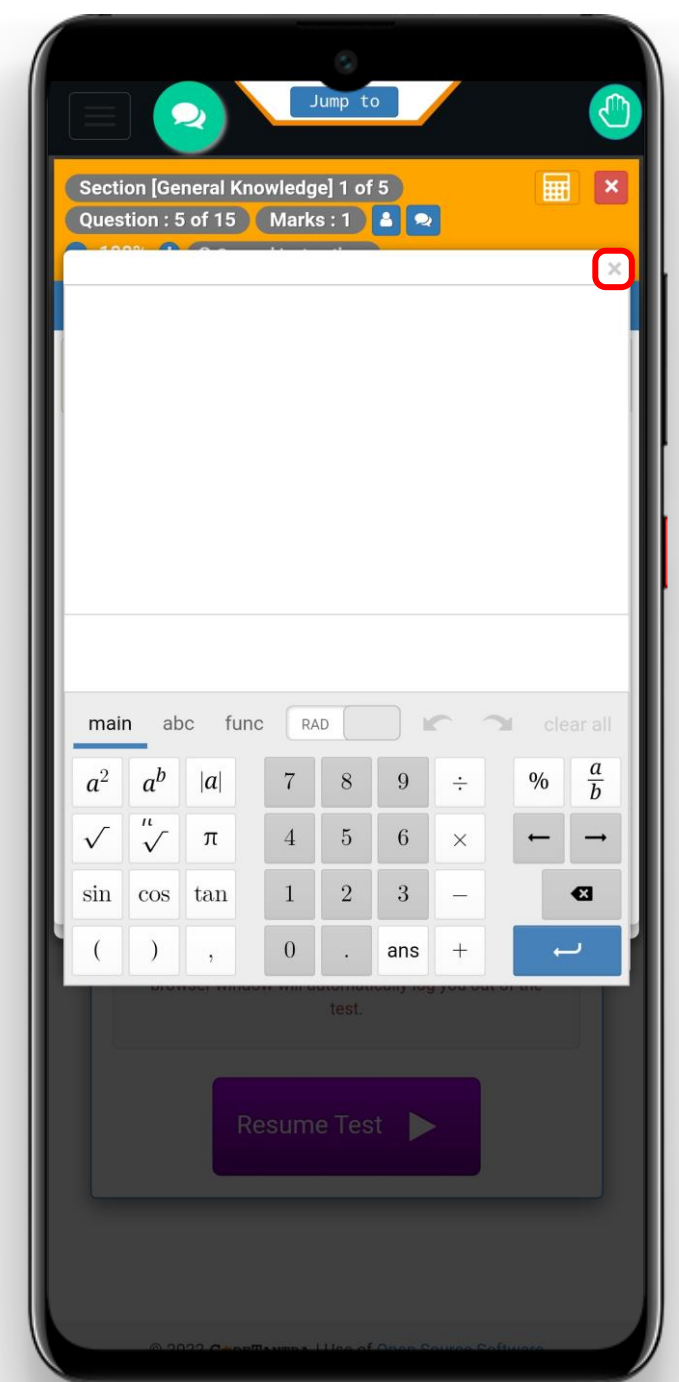
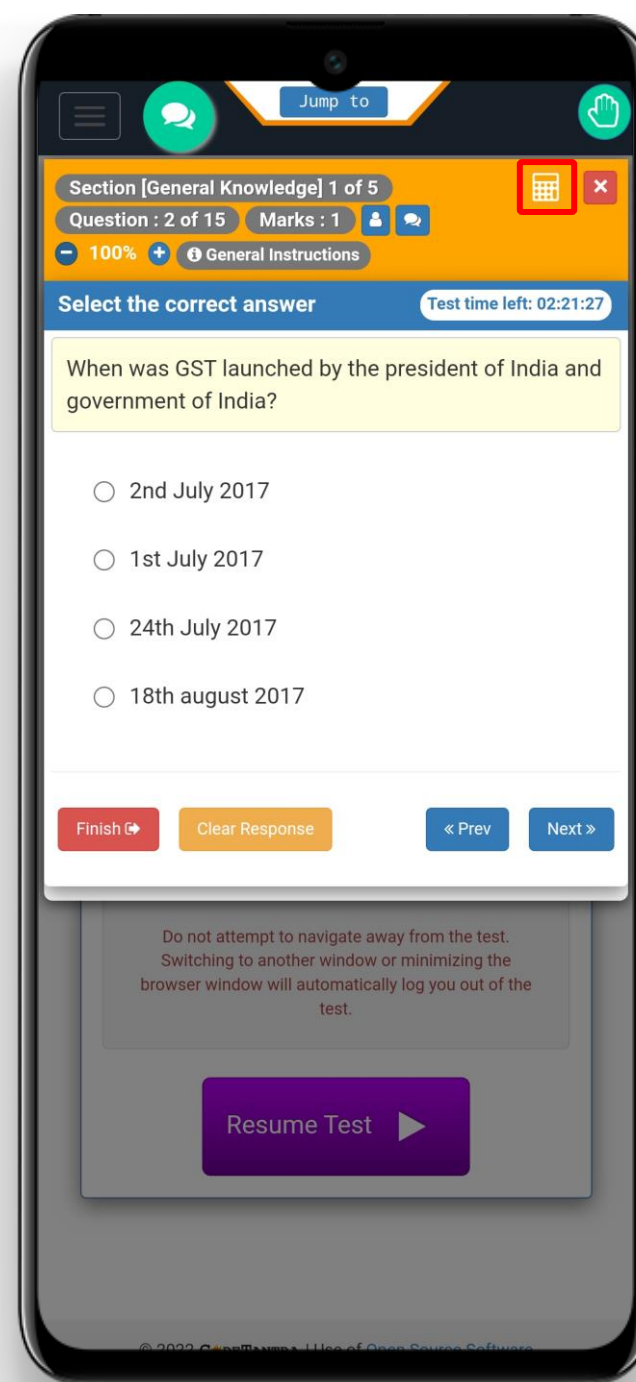
## Accessing On-Screen Calculator

You can click on the Calculator button to access on-screen calculator.

Once you are done using the calculator, you can click on the Cross mark to close the calculator.

### Important Note:

The on-screen calculator button appears only when it is allowed in the test.

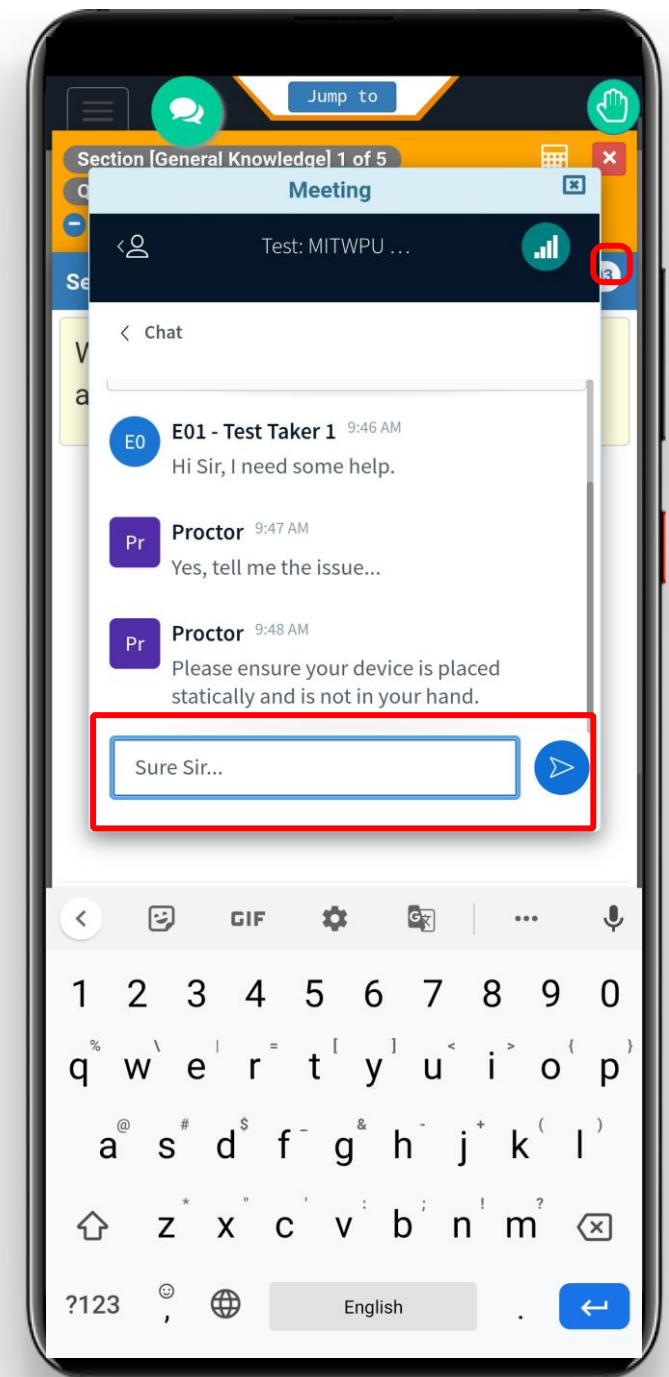
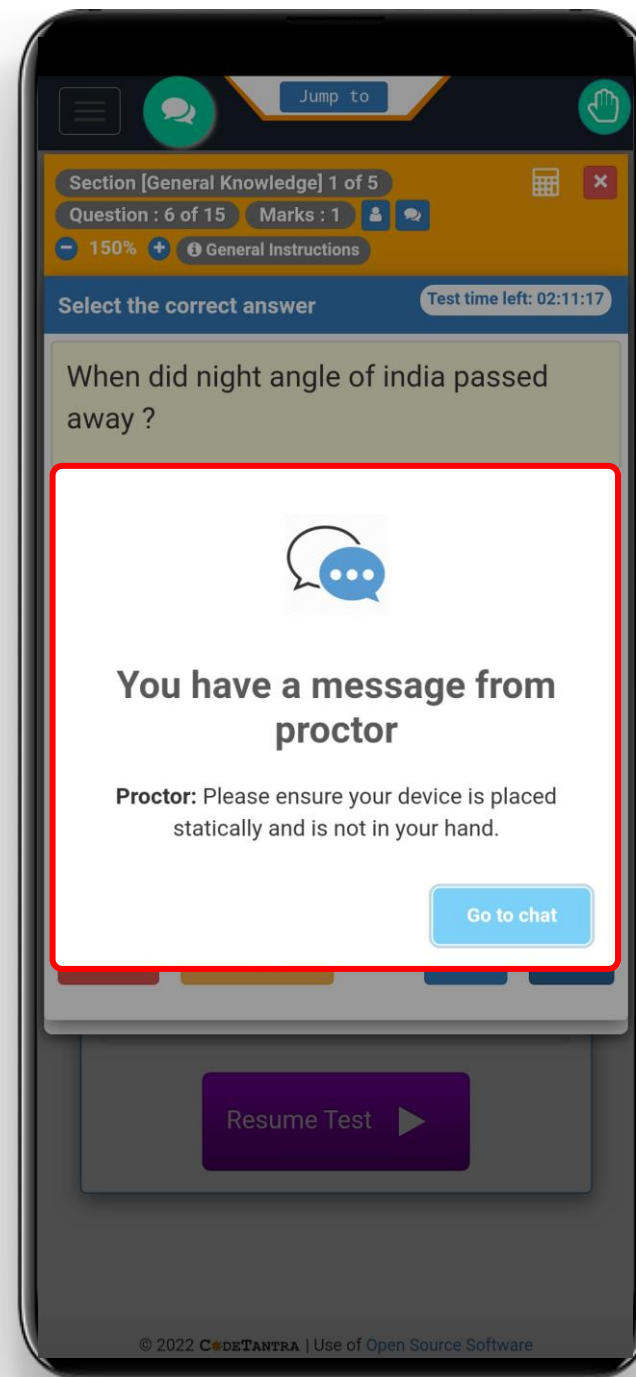




## Replying to Proctor's Message

If a proctor sends a message, you would be able to see a pop-up with the message.

Click on **Go to Chat** button to reply to the message.

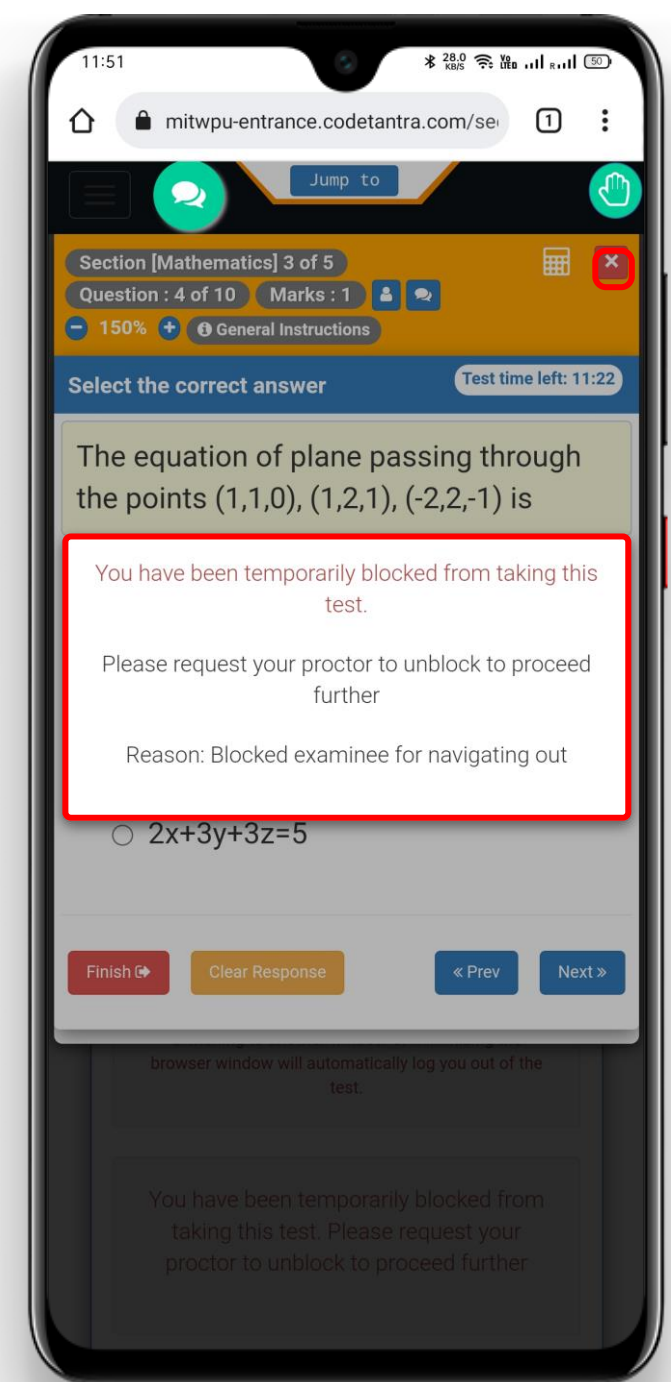
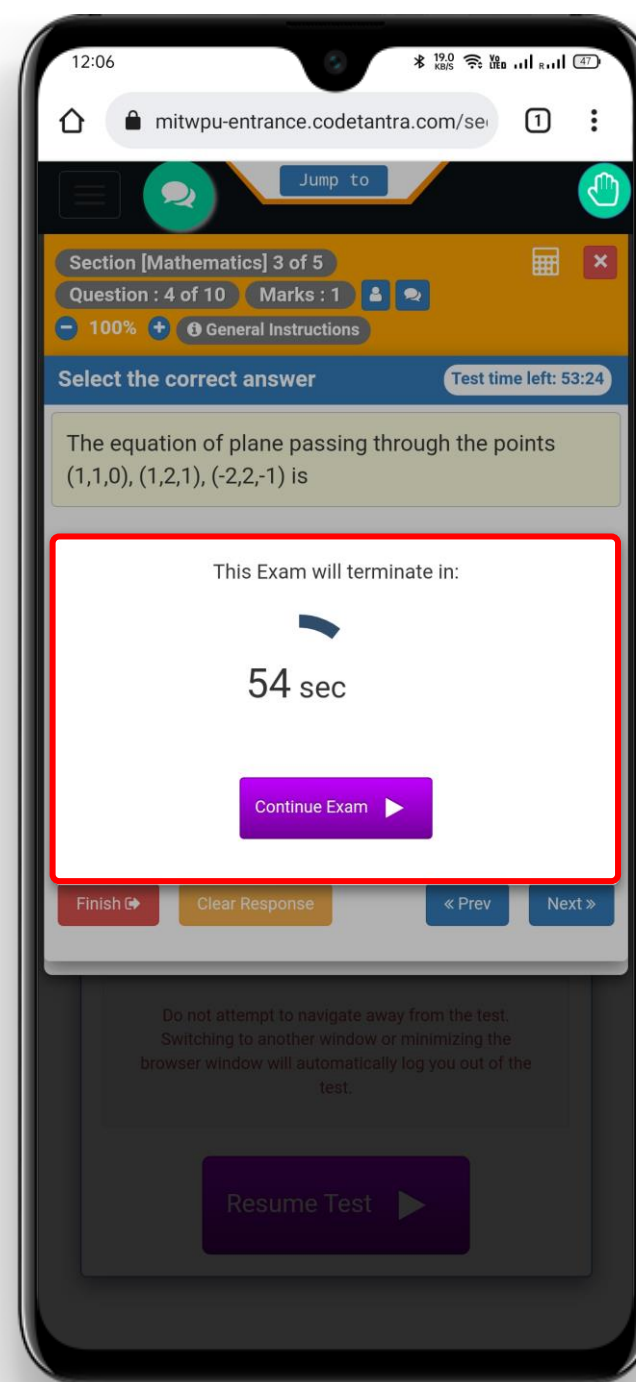


## Avoid Navigating from Test window

If you try to leave/minimize the exam window, then system will automatically **block** you from taking the test further as per the violation rules.

### Important Note:

Whenever you see the timer running in reverse direction on your screen that means you are not writing the exam in full screen mode. You should **immediately** click on **Continue Exam** button to go to full screen and avoid getting blocked.



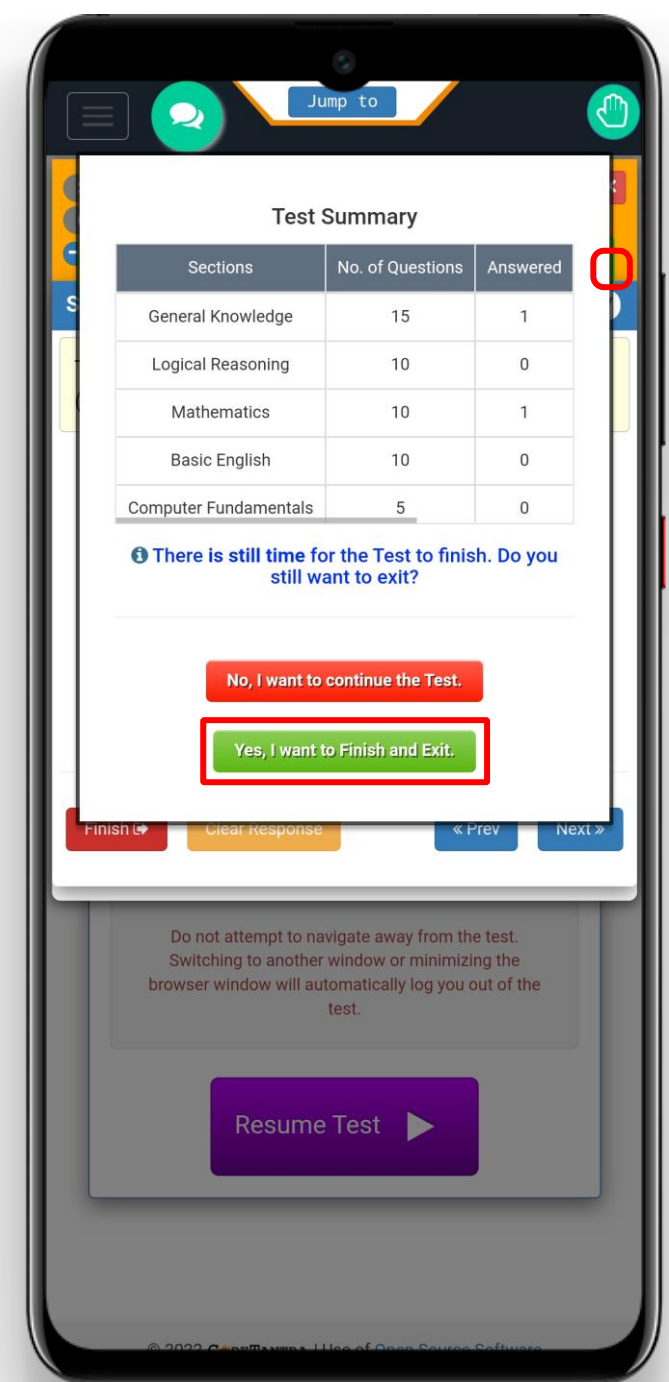
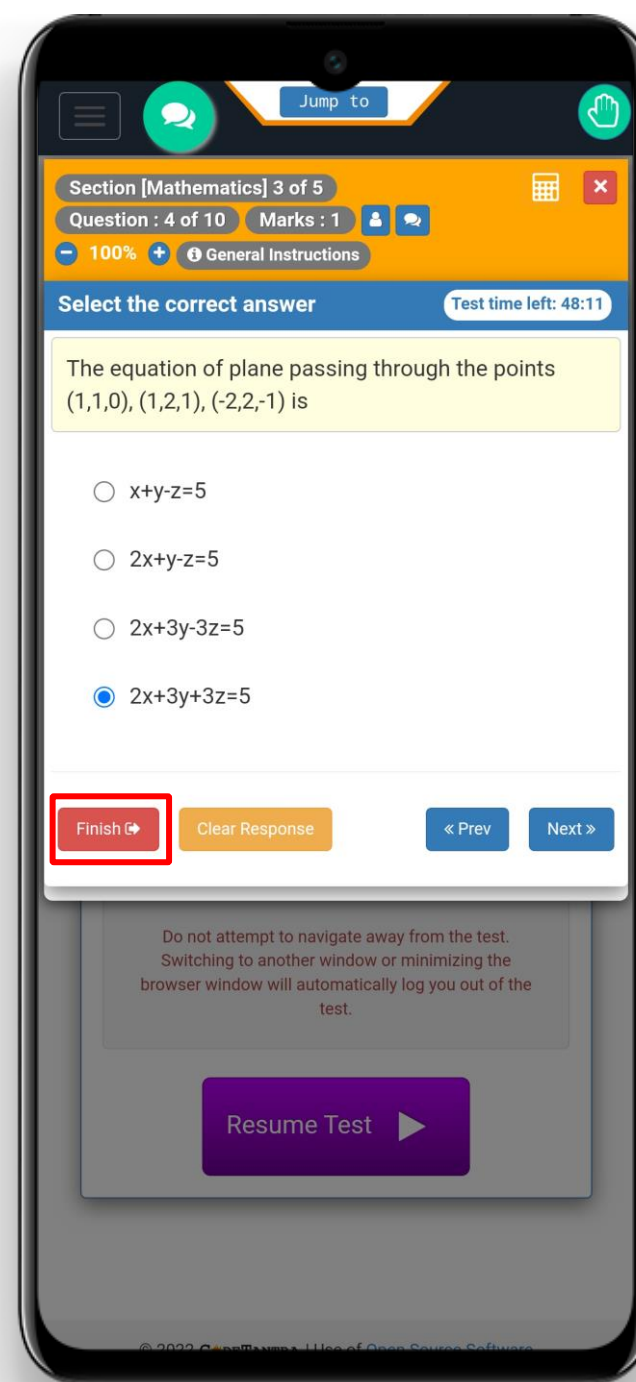
## Finishing the Test

Click on the **Finish** button to finish the test.

Click on **Yes, I want to Finish and Exit** button to confirm finishing the test.

### Important Note:

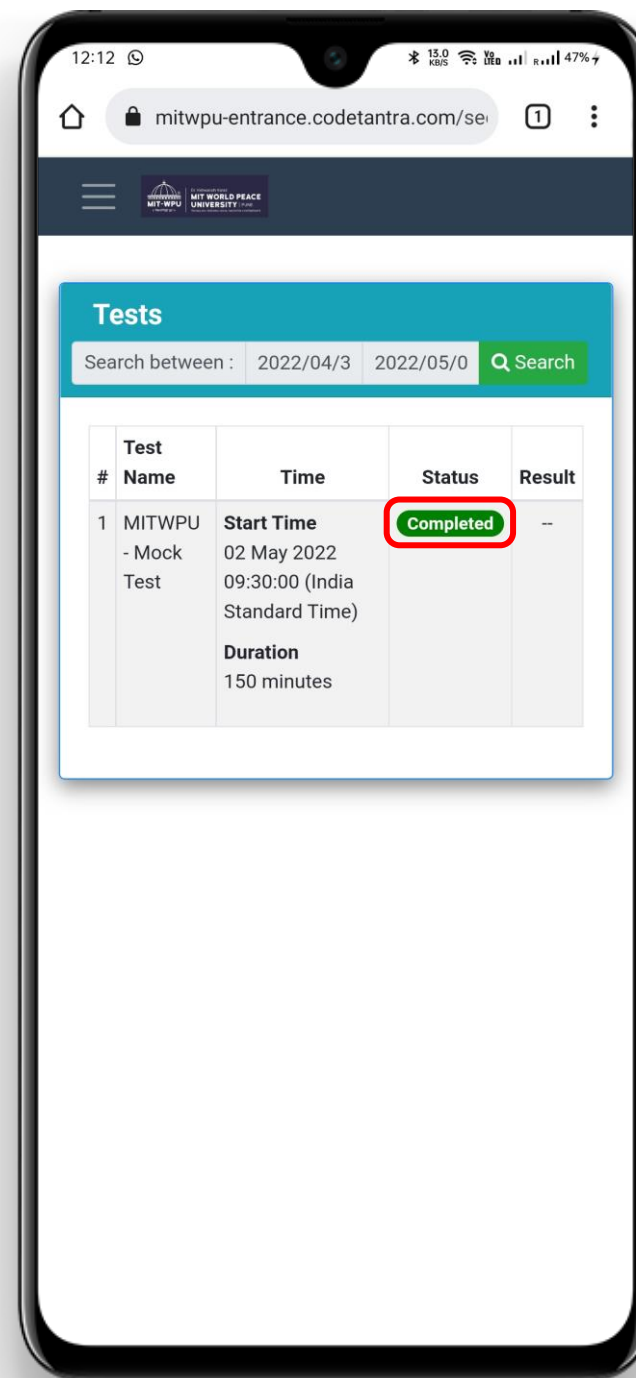
You can click on **No, I want to continue the Test** button to go back and continue writing the exam.
