2. Measures taken to complete the syllabus of courses and programs.	1. The group of developers within the IT section has made timely analyses regarding the online available systems and procured necessary platforms for classes such as MS-Teams, Zoom and WebEx. 2. Infrastructural capacities (internet, servers) have been increased which have enabled access for all students and staff without any difficulty. 3. University shifted from conventional teaching to online teaching with help of LMS. 4. University used Open Education Resources (OERs) including SWAYAM and NPTEL courses to make classes more engaging. 5. Training was conducted for professors and students for virtual learning platforms and necessary support was provided. 6. Teachers used online pedagogies such as Team Based Learning (TBL), discussion forums 7. Teachers conducted pre and post class activities using Learning Management System (LMS) to ensure active student engagement. 8. Teachers put a significant amount of effort in preparation of presentations and in-class activities. 9. Grading of a subject was done based on a few assignments and some on-line tests, quizzes. 10. Assignments consist of some conceptual questions and/or inferences drawn on the results of numerical examples 11. On-line tests are conducted through video-conferencing mode, where on-line invigilation is implemented through camera-based (mounted on the Laptop or mobile phone) vision and inspection system.
