Exit Feedback of students were conducted through Google form designed and circulated to all graduating students in year 2022.

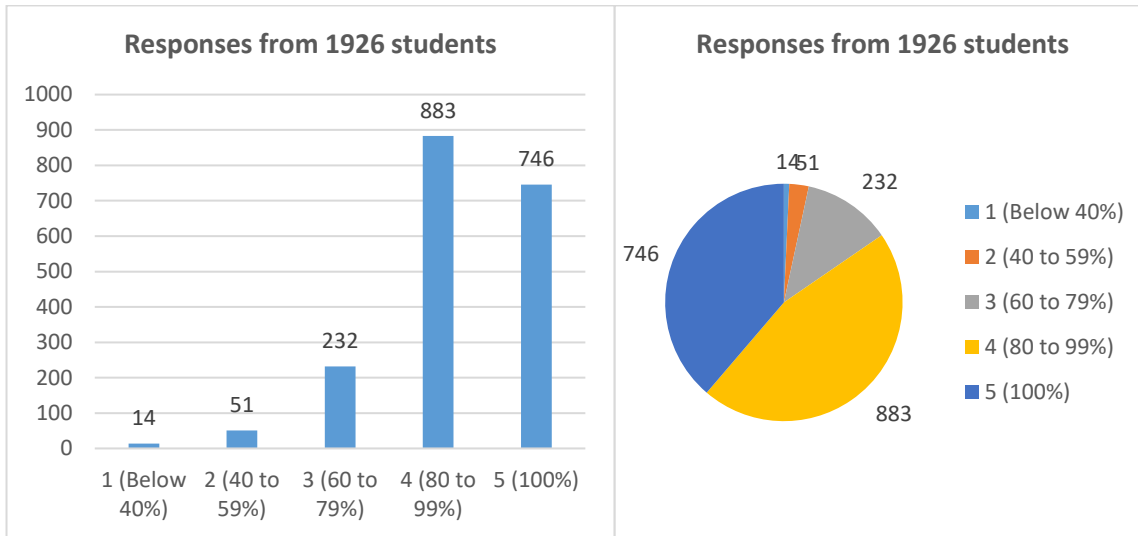

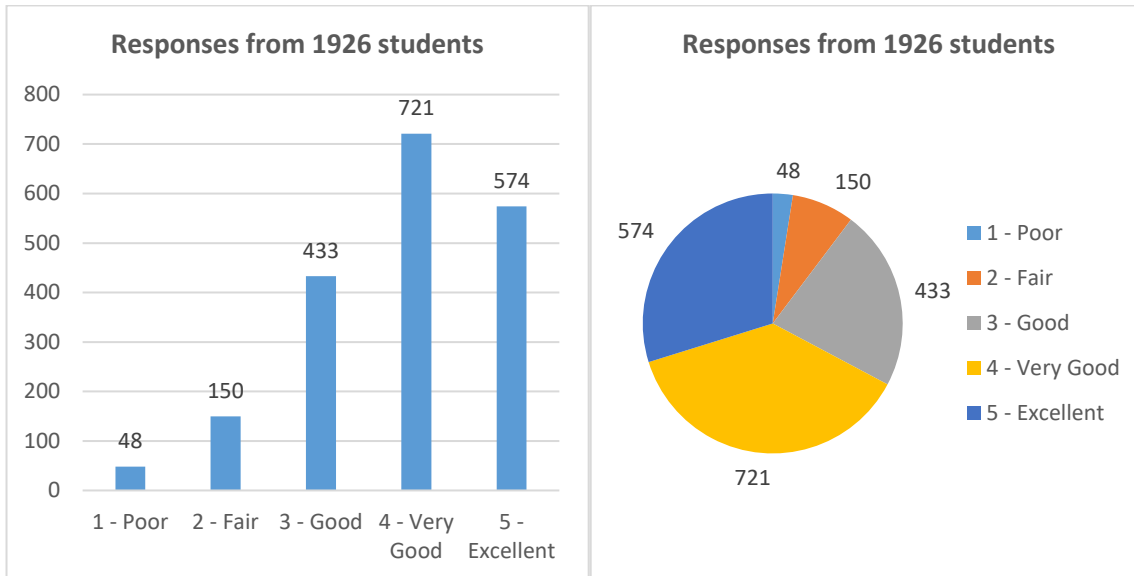

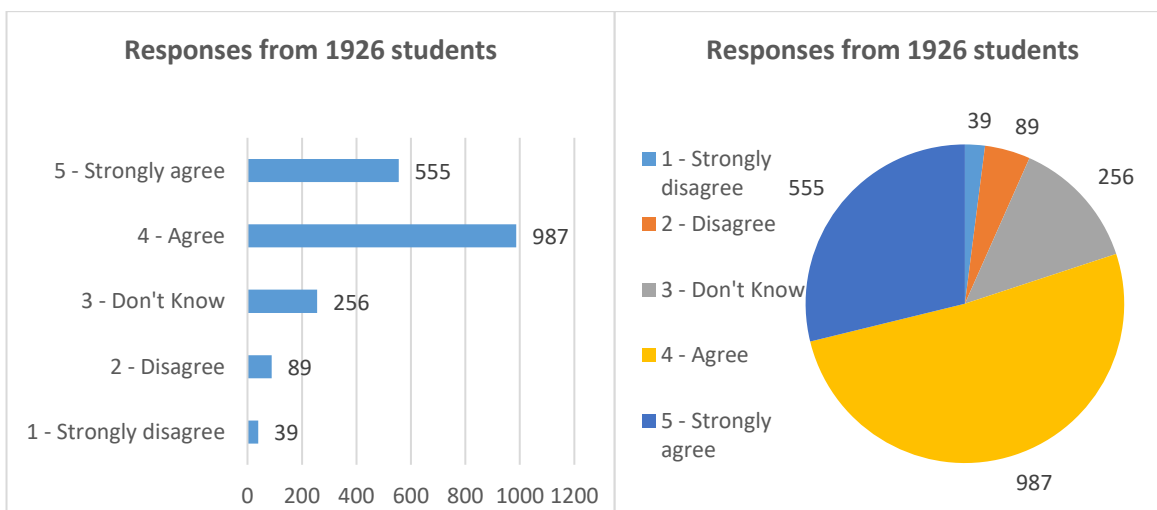

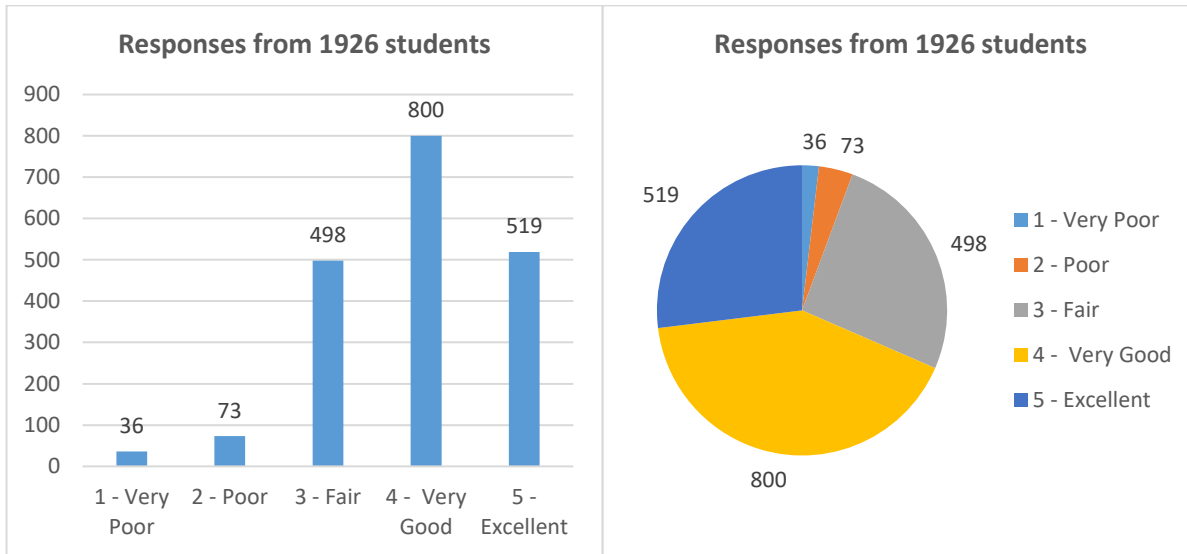

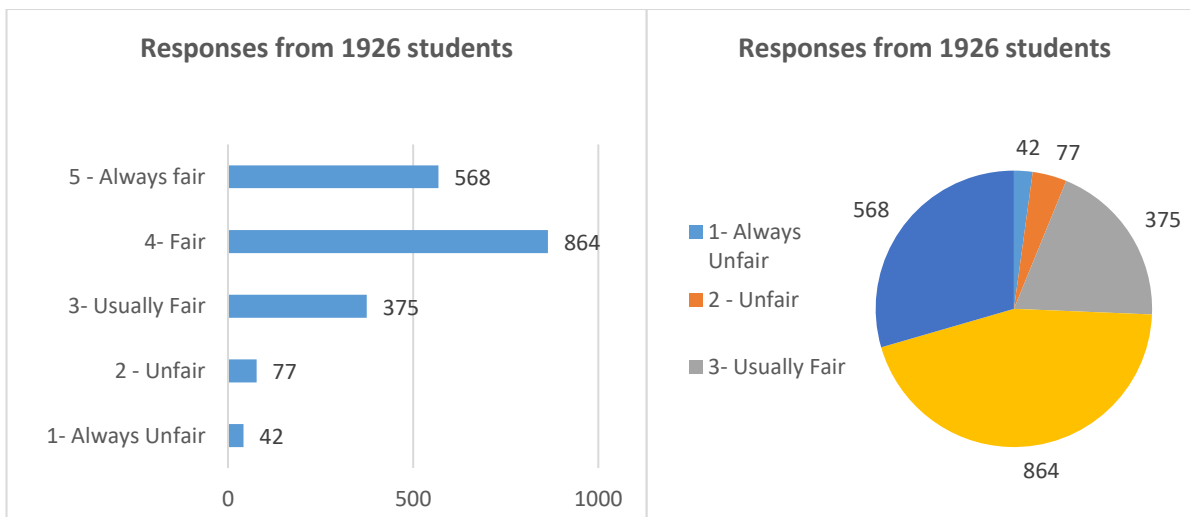

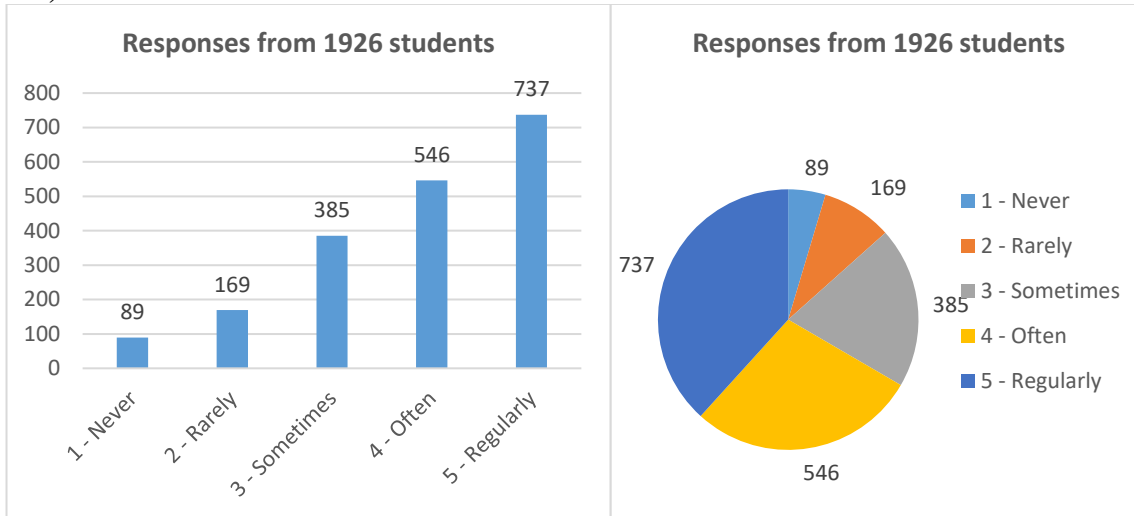

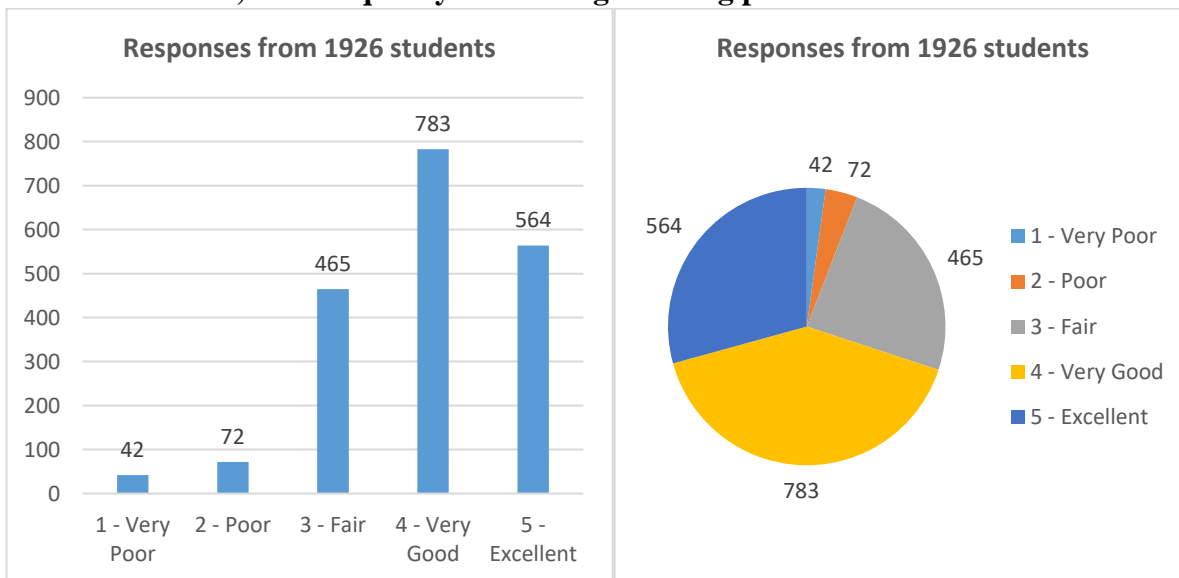

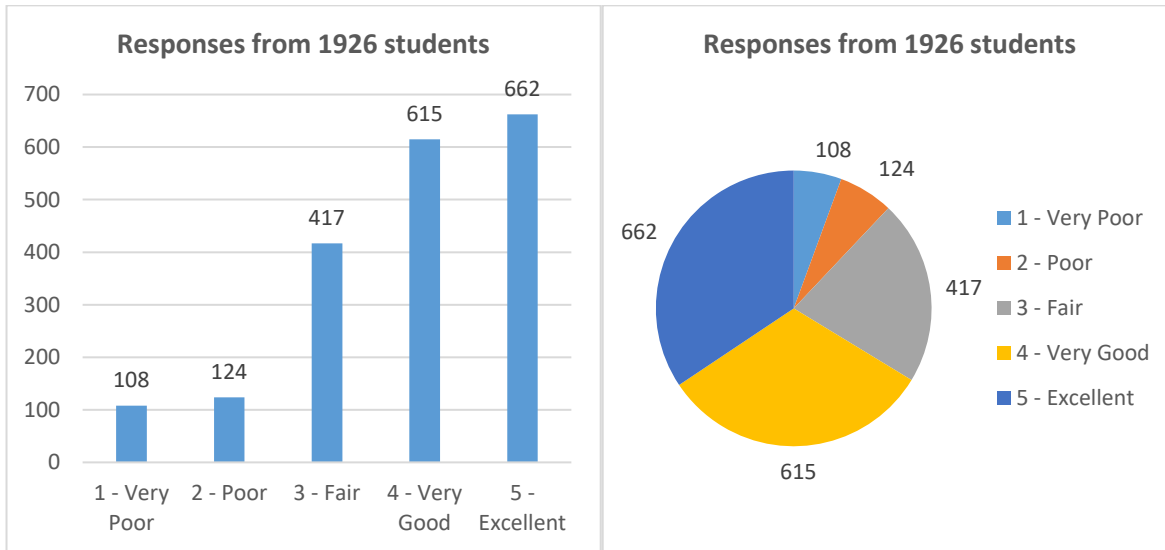

8. Rate on scale of 5, overall quality of teaching-learning process



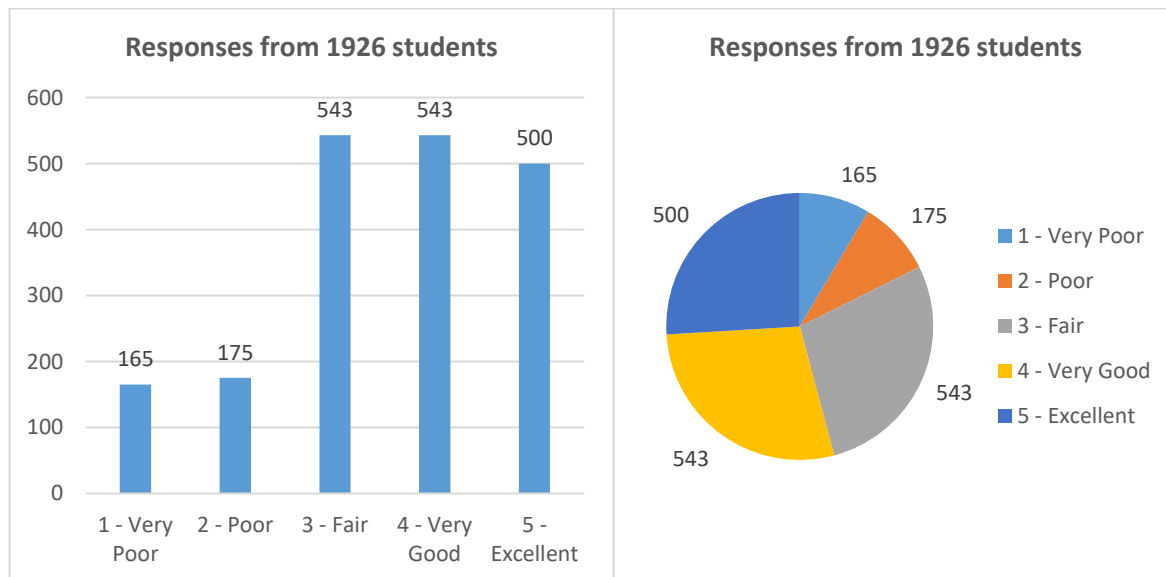

9. Rate Peace Courses on scale of 5



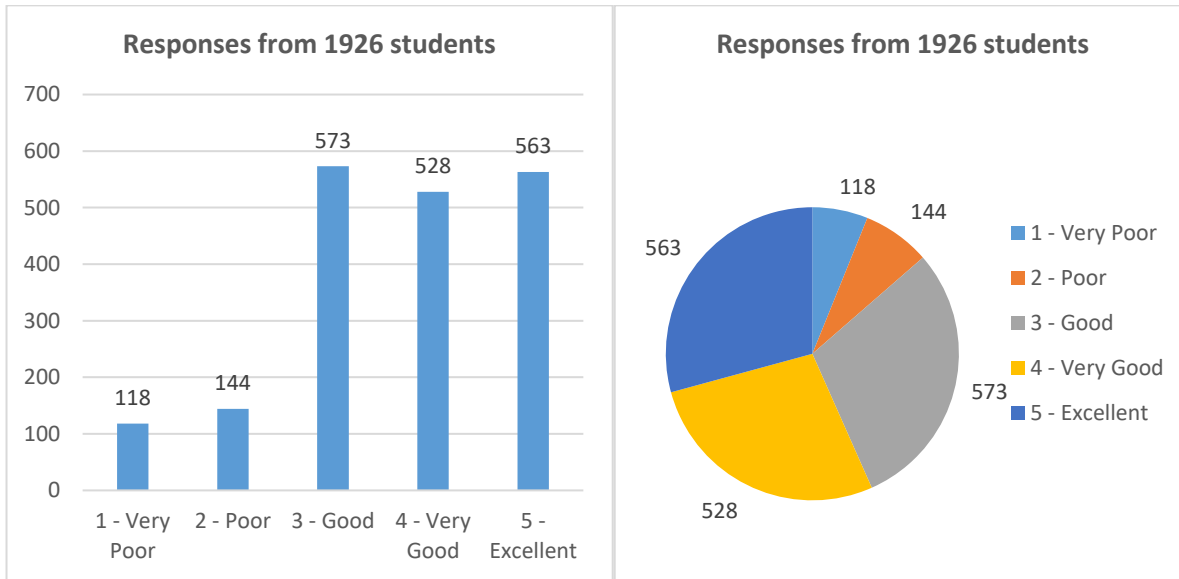

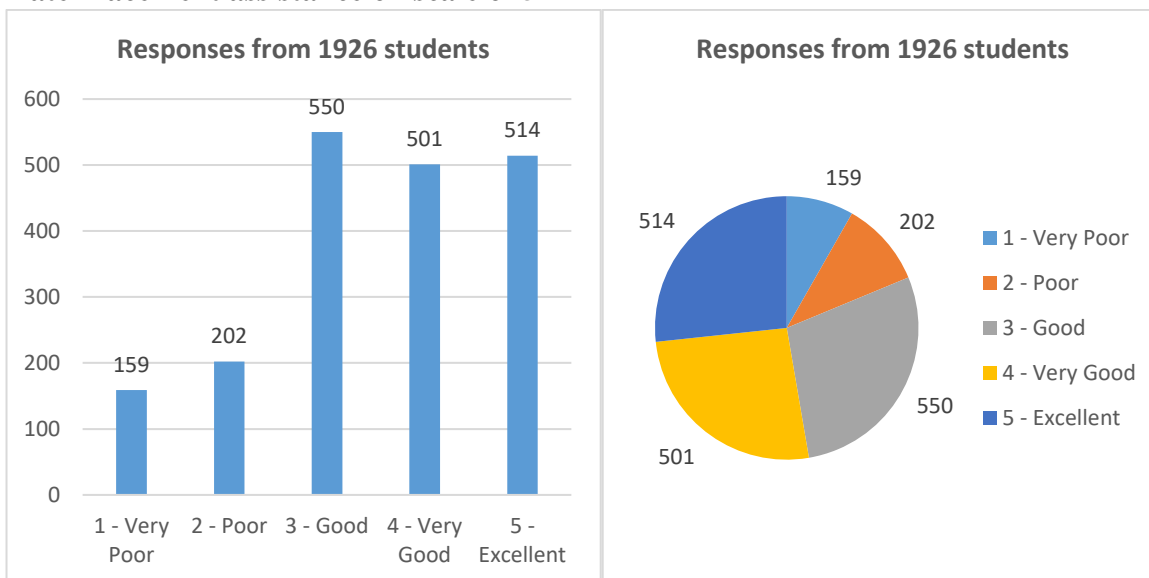

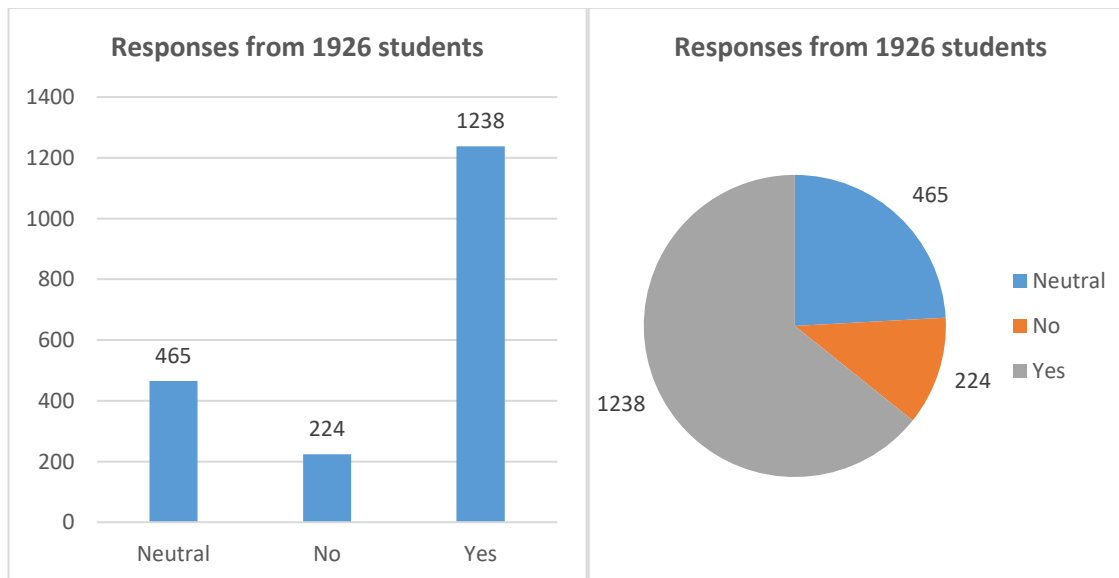

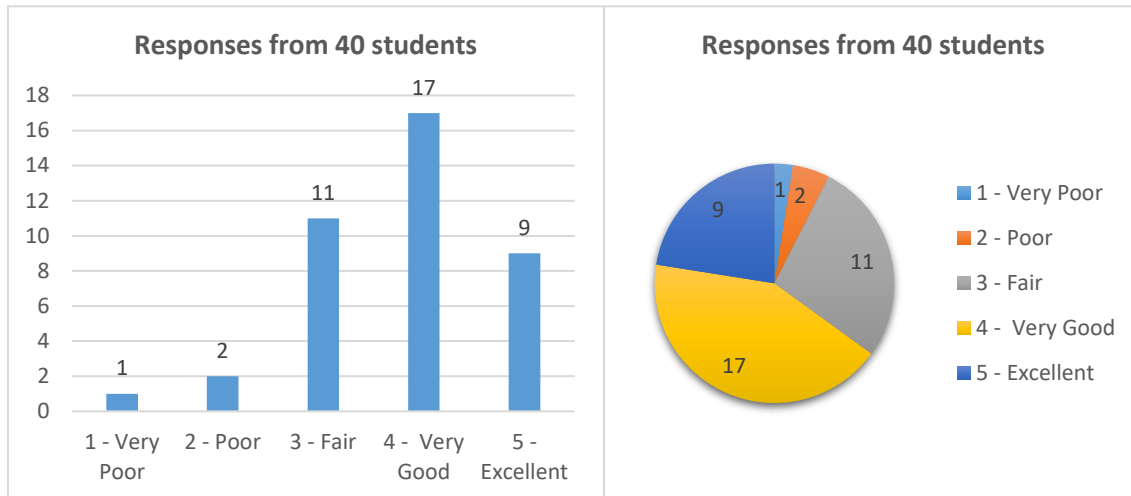
