Eligibility Criteria for A.Y. 2024-25

Eligibility Criteria

(1) For Maharashtra and All India Candidature Candidates.

- i. The Candidate should be an Indian National.
- i. Passed bachelor's degree in the relevant field of Engineering and Technology (4 years) from AICTE or Central or State Government approved institutions or equivalent, with at least 50% marks (at least 45% marks, in case of Backward class category candidate belonging to Maharashtra State only).
- ii. Obtained Non-zero Positive Score in Graduates Aptitude Test in Engineering (GATE 2024/2023/2022) conducted by Indian Institute of Technology/ MIT-WPU CET 2024.
- (2) <u>For sponsored candidates</u>: Minimum of two years of full-time work experience in a registered firm / company / industry / educational and / or research institute / any Government Department or Government Autonomous Organization in the relevant field in which admission is being sought.
- (3) Any other criterion declared from time to time by the appropriate authority as defined under the Act / by university.



Admission Selection Process

- Candidate should have obtained non-zero positive score in Graduate Aptitude Test in Engineering (GATE) conducted by Indian Institute of Technology, will be considered for the admission followed by Personal Interaction [PI].
- For admission under sponsored category, candidate should have minimum two years of full timework experience in a registered firm / company/ industry/ educational and/or research institute / any Government Department or Government Autonomous Organization in the relevant field in which admission is sought.
- For any vacant seats after the above process, candidates who do not have either GATE score or work experience will be considered for admission through a process of entrance test (MIT-WPU CET 2024) followed by Personal Interaction [PI].
- Admissions will be provided purely based on 'Allotment Round's' conducted by the University as per the schedule.
- Applicants who appear in the selection process without the pass status and mark sheet of a qualifying exam will be given Provisional Admission. Provisional Admission is not the final confirmation of the admission for a given program. After verification of all essential documents in Original and verification of the eligibility, the provisional admission will be confirmed as a Final Admission.
- Any other criterion declared from time to time by the appropriate authority as defined under the Act.

Reservation Policy

All the reservations given below shall be applicable to candidates belonging to Maharashtra state only subject to the fulfilment of the eligibility criteria specified by respective authorities from time to time.

(a) Reservation for Backward Class Category Candidates:

The percentage of seats reserved for candidates of backward class categories belonging to Maharashtra State is as given below. The percentage of reservations is the percentages of the seats available for Maharashtra candidates. Backward class candidates shall claim the category to which they belong at the time of submission of application form to MIT-WPU.

<u>Mote:</u> Special Backward Class will be offered reservation up to 2% of intake subject to availability of vacant seat under backward class reservation quota.

(b) Reservation for sons/daughters of Defence service personnel:

Five percent (5%) seats of the total sanctioned intake of an University for First Year M. Tech., subject to a maximum of five (5) seats in university shall be reserved for Children of ex- service personnel who are Domiciled in Maharashtra State (DEF-1), Children of active service personnel who are Domiciled in Maharashtra State (DEF-2), Children of active service personnel (DEF-3) Who are transferred to Maharashtra State but are not domiciled in Maharashtra State, or Who are not domiciled in Maharashtra State but their families are stationed in Maharashtra State under the provision of

retention of family accommodation at the last duty station on grounds of children's education provided further that, such candidate should have appeared and passed the HSC examination from a school/college situated in the State of Maharashtra.

- (i) These seats are within the sanctioned intake.
- (ii) A combined single merit list of all eligible DEF1, DEF2 and DEF3Candidates shall be prepared.
- (iii) Candidates claiming these seats shall produce additional documents in Proforma C, D and/or E as applicable available on the website.
- (iv) This provision is NOT available to the children of civilian staff who is working /who has worked in the Indian Defence Service.
- c) Eligibility criteria for Candidates belonging to Persons with Disability: In addition to the basic qualification mentioned above, candidate who is suffering from any one of the following permanent disabilities is eligible to seek admission against seats reserved for Persons with Disability candidates.

d) Reservation for Persons with Disability Candidate:

Three percent (3%) seats of total sanctioned intake of all the programs shall be reserved for Candidates with Disability.

- (i) 1% seats for visually impaired (blind) candidates (P1),
- (ii) 1% seats for Speech & hearing impaired (deaf & dumb) candidates(P2),
- (iii) 1% seats for orthopedic disorders, learning disabilities, Dyslexia, Dyscalculia, Dysgraphica, Spastic (P3).

The allotment of seats reserved for the Candidates with Disability shall be done on the basis of an inter-se merit of respective type of handicap of such candidates. These seats are available for Maharashtra domiciled candidates only. The candidates claiming reservation under this category shall submit the certificates strictly as per the Proforma.

Note: -

Candidates with Disability should note that on admission to degree course they will not be given any exemptions or additional facility in the academic activities other than those which may be provided by the respective department.



Reporting & Confirmation of Admission

- 1. Candidate shall confirm the admission by paying Rs.1,00,000/- by POS or Demand Draft in the name of "Dr. Vishwanath Karad MIT World Peace University, Pune" as Seat Acceptance fee/ 1st installment of fee and by submitting required documents in original to respective institute, to which admission is granted as per schedule.
- 2. If a candidate is unable to produce original certificates at the time of his/her admission on account of admission already secured to some other institution, he or she shall produce a certificate from the Head of the institution where he/she has already taken admission indicating that he/she has been admitted to a particular course in that institution on a particular date and hence original certificates have been retained in that institution. The candidate shall produce the attested copies of the certificates duly attested by the Head of the concerned institution. Such candidates shall be required to pay the fees immediately at the time of admission and such candidates shall be permitted to submit the required original certificates within 04 working days after the date of payment of fees.





Cancellation Policy

MIT-WPU will consider any request for cancellation / withdrawal of admission from studies only if such request is made in accordance with the regulations prescribed by the University. The Regulations have included a procedure for cancellation/withdrawal as well as the rules for refunds.

Cancellation Description	Refund Calculation Procedure
1. Withdrawal Requests received before the commencement of the program.	The entire academic fee after deducting the processing fee of Rs.1,000/- will be refunded.
2. Withdrawal Requests received within 10 days after the commencement of classes	The entire academic fee after deducting 10% will be refunded.
3. Withdrawal Requests received after 10 days and within 20 days from the commencement of classes	The entire academic fee after deducting 20% will be refunded.
4. Withdrawal Requests received after 20 days and within 30 days from the commencement of classes.	The entire academic fee after deducting 50% will be refunded.
5. Withdrawal Requests received after 30 days	No refund of any academic fees

Conditions:

- Request for cancellation of admissions may be sent through registered email to the email id mentioned in the offer guide.
- > A refund will be made as per the university norms.
- A refund will be made only after submission of proof of fee paid, Provisional Seat Allotment Letter and no dues certificate from concern department. The refund will be made through account transfer to the account number mentioned in the withdrawal request. Hence, the correct bank account details may be provided in the withdrawal request.
- A refund would be considered only on the total course fee. No refund shall be allowed in respect of Application Fees and any other levies.
- In case the student fails to fulfil the eligibility criterion, then the student must communicate the same to the University within 10 days from the date of declaration of result from the concerned Board/University. If the seat thus vacant is filled, then in such cases the university would refund the Fee Paid after deducting Rs.10,000/-, else no refund shall be admissible.



Important Notes:

- a) All refunds shall be remitted only to the bank account of the student/parent as per the NEFT details furnished and shall be made within 20 working days from the date of approval of the cancellation/withdrawal.
- b) All disputes related to refund of fees are subject to Pune jurisdiction only.
- c) In case an applicant has submitted a fake score, false/incorrect/incomplete information, then the student is liable to be cancelled for the admission, without any intimation and no refund of fees, at any stage during his tenure at university. In such cases, legal action may be taken.
