

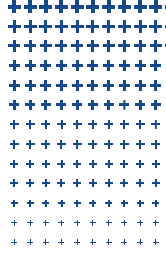

# MIT-WPU School of Government Scholarship Policy

## + Required Skillset

The Scholarship Policy of the MIT-WPU School of Government (MITSOG) outlines the guidelines and principles for awarding scholarships to deserving students pursuing education within the School of Government. The policy aims to promote academic excellence, encourage talent, and foster an equal opportunities environment for students willing to build careers in the sphere of politics and governance

## + Purpose

The purpose of the Scholarship Policy is to support and recognize outstanding students who demonstrate exceptional academic achievements, leadership potential, and a commitment to making a positive impact in the field of public administration, governance, and related disciplines. By offering scholarships, MITSOG aims to make quality education accessible to deserving students, thus contributing to the development of future leaders in the public sector.

## + Applicability

This policy is applicable to students enrolling in programmes offered by MITSOG in the Academic Year 2023-2024. The scholarships provided under this policy are solely for students pursuing studies within the School of Government and are subject to the terms and conditions outlined in this policy.

## + Scholarship Committee

- + Executive President, MIT-WPU
  - + General Secretary, Foundation for Democratic Reforms
  - + Distinguished political leader/public policy/public administration expert
  - + Member Secretary (Senior Director, MITSOG)
  - + Senior Academic from MITSOG.

- The Scholarship Committee will be responsible for evaluating scholarship applications, selecting deserving candidates and ensuring transparency in the entire process.
  - Member composition of the committee will be finalized by the Member Secretary in consultation with the university management.

### + Scholarship Eligibility

For students enrolled in MIT-WPU School of Government (MITSOG) in MPG programme.

### + Scholarship Award Process

All scholarships for MITSOG will be awarded based on merit and/or family income or a blend of both. The applicants must provide IT returns of self, parents, all income certificate, and others as applicable on a case-to-case basis.

**Step 1:** Complete and submit questionnaire - based application form

**Step 2:** Online Interview (Optional – wherever required)

**Step 3:** Final selection based on assessment in Step 1 and 2, subject to fulfilment of eligibility criteria

**Selection Weightage (100%) - Questionnaire Response (70%) : Graduation Score (30%)**

### + Terms & Conditions

- + The specific details and provisions of the Scholarship Policy, including the types of scholarships available, eligibility criteria, application process, award of scholarships, and any additional requirements, will be defined and communicated by the Scholarship Committee of the MIT-WPU School of Government, and will be subject to periodic review and updates, as deemed necessary by the management.
- + Scholarships may be awarded on a one-time basis or renewable for subsequent academic years, subject to the recipients' continued eligibility and compliance with the scholarship terms.
- + To maintain their scholarships, students must meet the academic performance standards and adhere to the code of conduct set forth by the School of Government. Failure to meet these requirements may result in the suspension or revocation of the scholarship.
- + The Scholarship Policy may be subject to periodic review and updates, as deemed necessary by the authorities of the MIT-WPU School of Government. Any modifications to the policy will be communicated to all relevant stakeholders.
- + This scholarship is applicable towards Tuition Fees and Development Fees only.
- + Students receiving a scholarship of 50% and above are required to bear the cost of all field trips on their own. This will be communicated once the field trips are finalized during the course of the year.
