INR 2500/- (Degree certificate by post Rs 500 and Rs 2000 **MIT-WPU Alumni Association Lifetime Membership**)

Note:

- 1) The Alumni fees is compulsory to everyone which the graduating students of 2022-23 should be charged **one-time joining fees of Rs 2,000**. Details are attached in the email.
- 2) The Convocation Registration fees is non-refundable.
- 3) The student does not collect his/her degree certificate after the convocation then **Search fees** charges will be applicable for the Degree certificate as per passing year.
