The Unwritten Prescription

Calcutta, Summer of 1886. The city sweated under the colonial sun, the streets murmuring with resistance and reform. In the narrow corridors of Calcutta Medical College, a hush fell as Kadambini Ganguly stepped into her final examination room India's first female medical student, sari neatly draped, stethoscope hanging like quiet armor. She was the only woman among dozens of male students, many of whom whispered that her dreams were "impossible."

Women, they said, belonged in the kitchen, not in clinics. But Kadambini didn't just walk into rooms; she made space where there was none. She passed!

But her real challenge began after the degree patients hesitated, colleagues dismissed her, and society mocked her. Once, a powerful editor published a column calling her "a shameless woman who dared to step outside her home." Instead of anger, Kadambini wrote back not with bitterness, but with brilliance. "If seeking knowledge and serving others is shameless," she said, "then let us all be shameless." That summer, she began treating women who had never seen a doctor before.

One patient, a young girl of twelve, once whispered, "Didi, I want to be like you." Kadambini paused. She knew that in that moment, a possibility was born not just in medicine, but in a young mind that dared to dream beyond the barriers of caste, gender, and colonial rule.

I chose to share this story not just because it's inspiring, but because Dr. Kadambini Ganguly's courage lit a spark in me. Her story taught me that knowledge becomes powerful only when it serves others when it heals, uplifts, and transforms.

In today's world, where challenges to society and Mother Nature are ever-growing, I feel a deep responsibility to contribute not just with good intentions, but through meaningful action. Just as Kadambini broke boundaries to serve humanity, I too aspire to use my education and abilities to work for the betterment of our society and protection of our environment. This life we are given is a gift from Mother Earth, and I believe the best way to honour that gift is by giving back by planting hope, healing divisions, and protecting the planet that sustains us.

Her story is not just a chapter in history— It is a spark, a reminder, a call to action.
