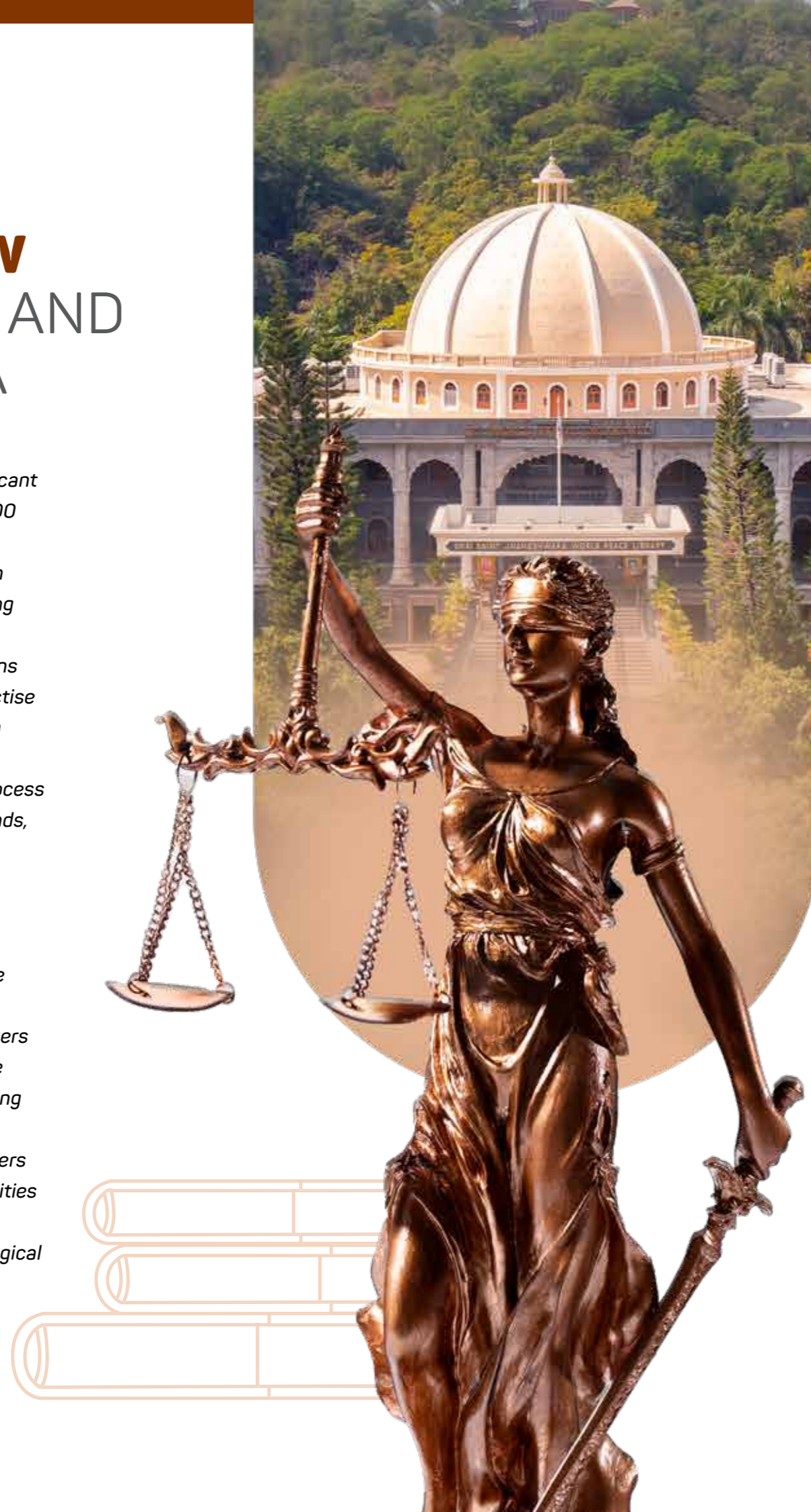


# Charting Careers in Law

These graduates find opportunities in various sectors, with approximately 30-40% joining the corporate sector in law firms, corporate legal departments, or as legal advisors. Litigation remains popular, attracting 40-50% of graduates who practise in courts nationwide. Many law graduates also join government services as public prosecutors, legal advisors, and in administrative roles. The Legal Process Outsourcing (LPO) sector employs tens of thousands, providing legal support to international clients.

Emerging trends include a growing demand for specialists in alternative dispute resolution (ADR), as businesses seek quicker, cost-effective dispute resolution methods. The rise of technology and digital transactions is increasing the need for lawyers specialising in tech and cyber law. Additionally, the integration of technology in legal practice is creating new roles and opportunities for tech-savvy law graduates. Overall, the legal profession in India offers diverse and rewarding career paths, with opportunities in traditional practice, corporate law, government services, and emerging sectors driven by technological advancements and globalisation.

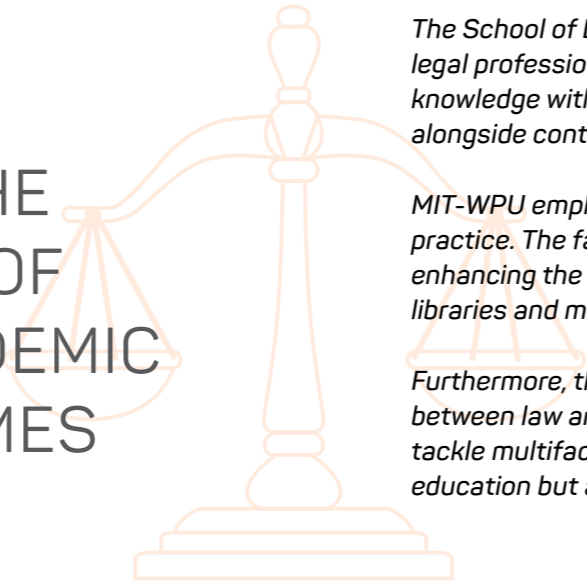

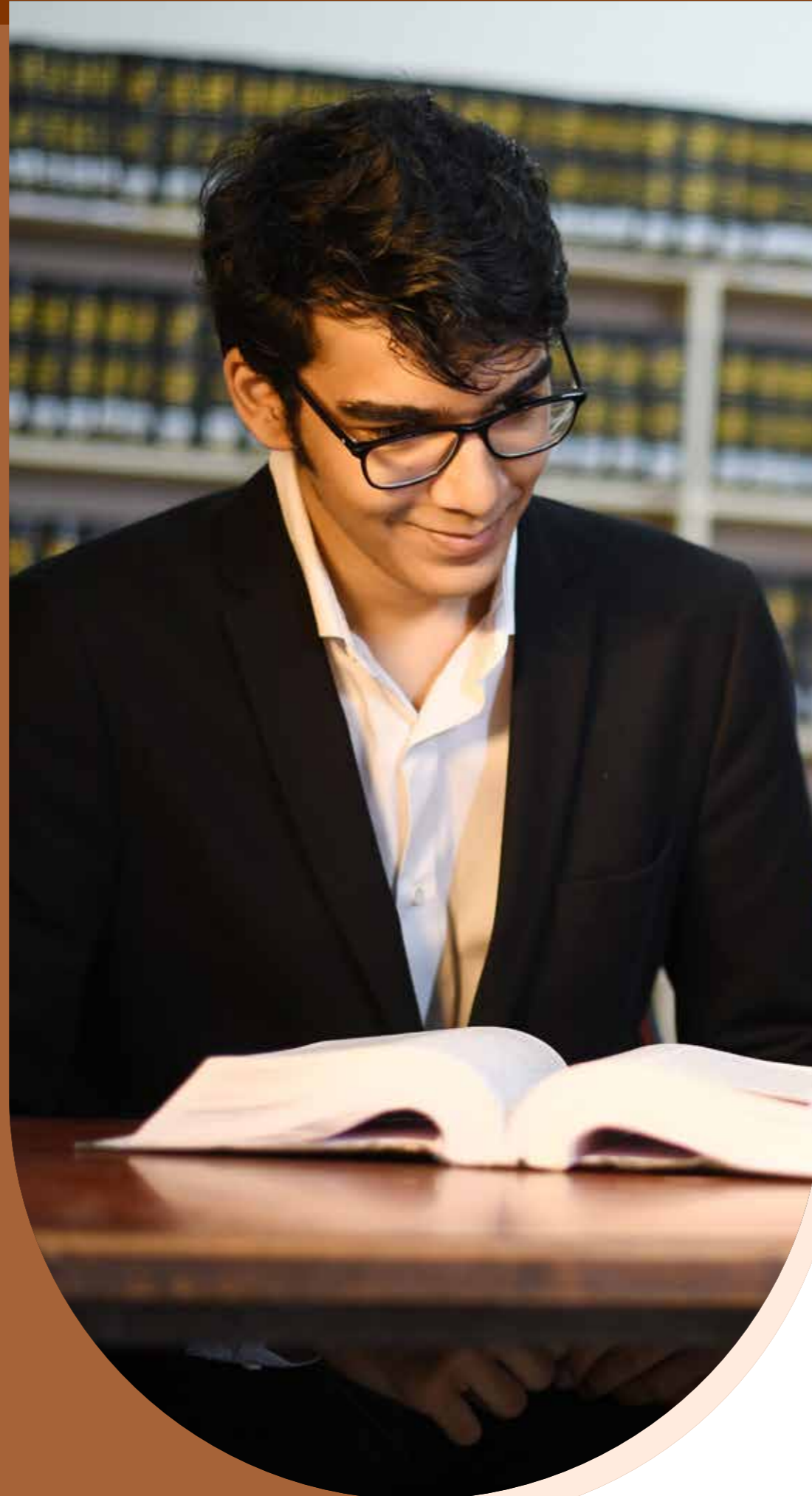

# Ph.D. in Law

Tailored for postgraduate students, this programme is meticulously crafted to cultivate research acumen and prepare students for careers in academia or research. A core feature of the programme is its specialised training in essential research components, encompassing analytical identification of substantive or procedural laws, hypothesis formulation, research question development, literature review, research ethics, and the adept use of online tools and resources. This programme lays emphasis on interdisciplinary research, encouraging students to explore innovative and entrepreneurial ideas within their chosen fields of study.

Students are guided in the selection of pertinent research topics and guided through the systematic development of their theses, typically spanning 40,000 to 50,000 words. Student progress is assessed at regular intervals to ensure scholarly excellence. Moreover, students are encouraged to disseminate their research findings by publishing papers in reputable journals, benefitting from the expertise of faculty members with extensive research experience. During the initial six months, common courses are offered to help students fortify their scientific aptitude and optimise their research outputs. The Ph.D. in Law programme also facilitates the establishment of valuable researcher networks and supports the formulation and successful execution of Ph.D. project plans. It aims to endow students with a broad foundation of knowledge and expertise to pave the way for their future careers.

### R.I.D.E

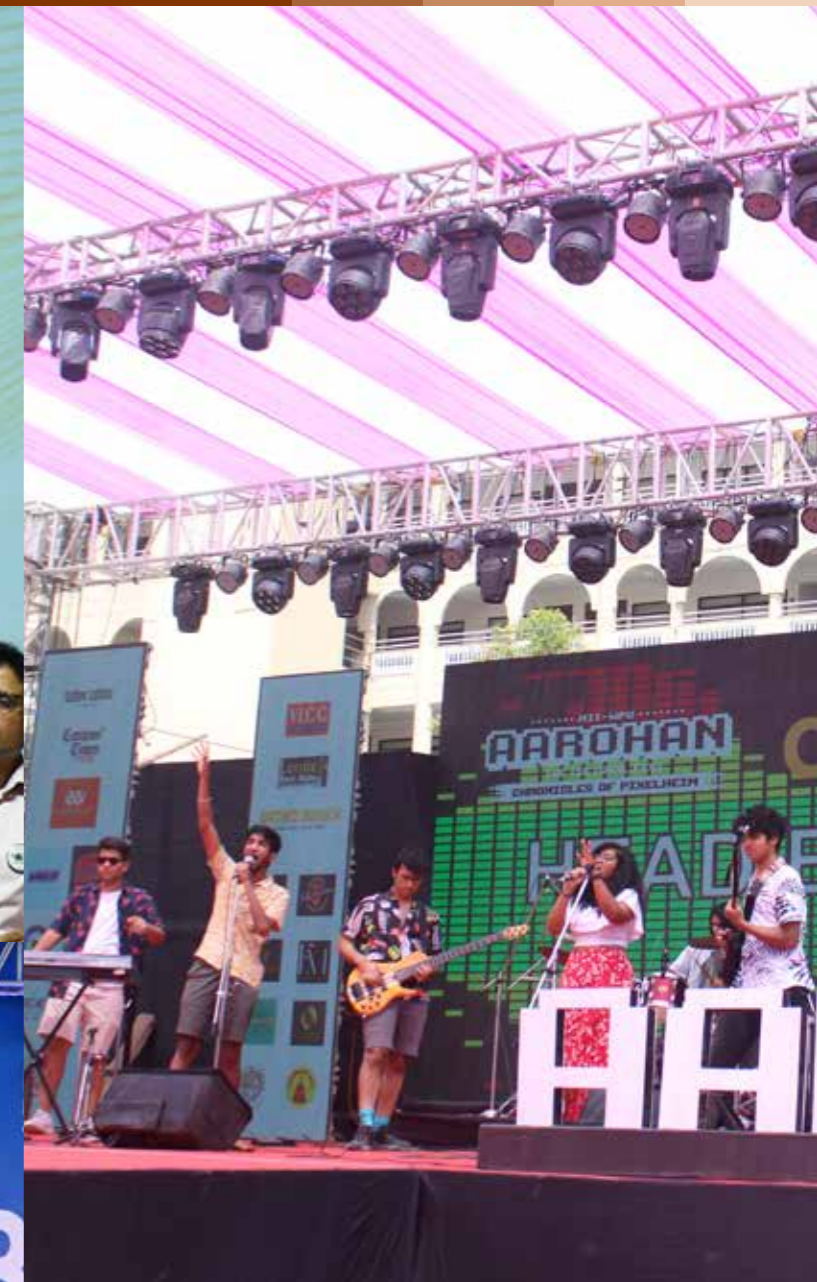

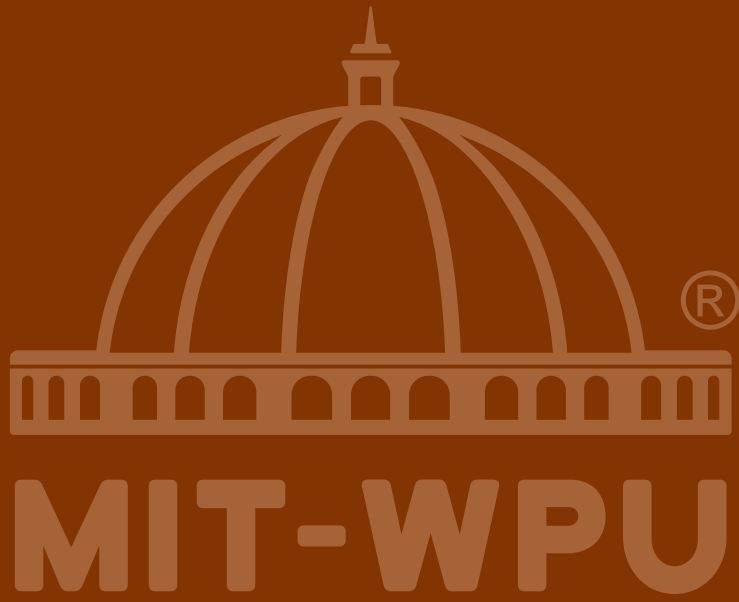
