Eligibility & Selection Criteria

Undergraduate Programme

- ◆ Minimum 50% aggregate score in 10+2/Class 12 or equivalent examination with English as a subject (at least 45% marks, in case of Backward class category candidate belonging to the State of Maharashtra only)
- or
- ◆ Minimum 50% aggregate score in a 3-year Diploma from any Government-approved Institution or equivalent with English as a subject.

Selection Process

BA Liberal Arts

- ◆ The selection is based on a SOP (Statement of Purpose) and Group Discussion.

BA English | BA Psychology | BA Political Science

- ◆ The selection process is based on the class 12 aggregate marks and a Statement of Purpose (500 words) written by eligible candidates.

- ◆ Minimum 55% aggregate score in 3/4-year graduation in any stream from a UGC-approved University or equivalent (at least 45% marks, in case of Backward class category candidate belonging to the State of Maharashtra only)

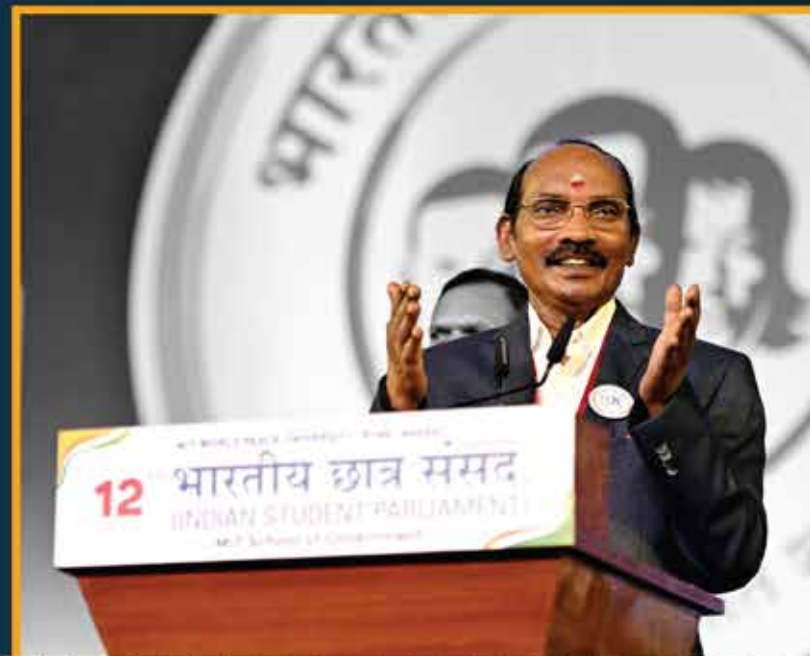


Bharatiya Chhatra Sansad Empowering Youth for Change
