Eligibility Criteria

Minimum 55% aggregate marks in a graduation degree in Civil Engineering /Construction / Infrastructure Engineering/ Environmental Engineering/ Architecture or Allied Branches* (Electrical Engineering, Mechanical Engineering, Industrial Engineering, Production Engineering) from AICTE / UGC / COA approved institution / university (Minimum 50% aggregate marks for candidates belonging to the reserved category from Maharashtra State).

AND

A minimum of 50% aggregate marks in Class 10 (SSC) and Class 12 (HSC) examinations, with English as a compulsory subject.

AND

A valid non-zero score in the relevant entrance examination conducted by the competent authority.

Selection Process

Candidates will also be evaluated through a 50-mark Personal Interaction (PI) score conducted by MIT-WPU as per the prescribed schedule, along with consideration of their past academic record and work experience.

AND

Admission will be based on the merit of a valid score in CAT 2025, XAT 2026, NMAT 2025, GMAT, CMAT 2026, MAH-CET 2026, PERA 2026 or MAT (September 2025 onwards) with valid (non-zero) national-level entrance score.

Note: Working professionals will get higher weightage in the selection process.

A) MIT-WPU Scholarship

MIT-WPU offers financial assistance and scholarships to meritorious students based on their academic performance in the National level/State Level entrance exams / Entrance Examination conducted by MIT-WPU (MIT-WPU CBT Score) for the academic year 2026-27.

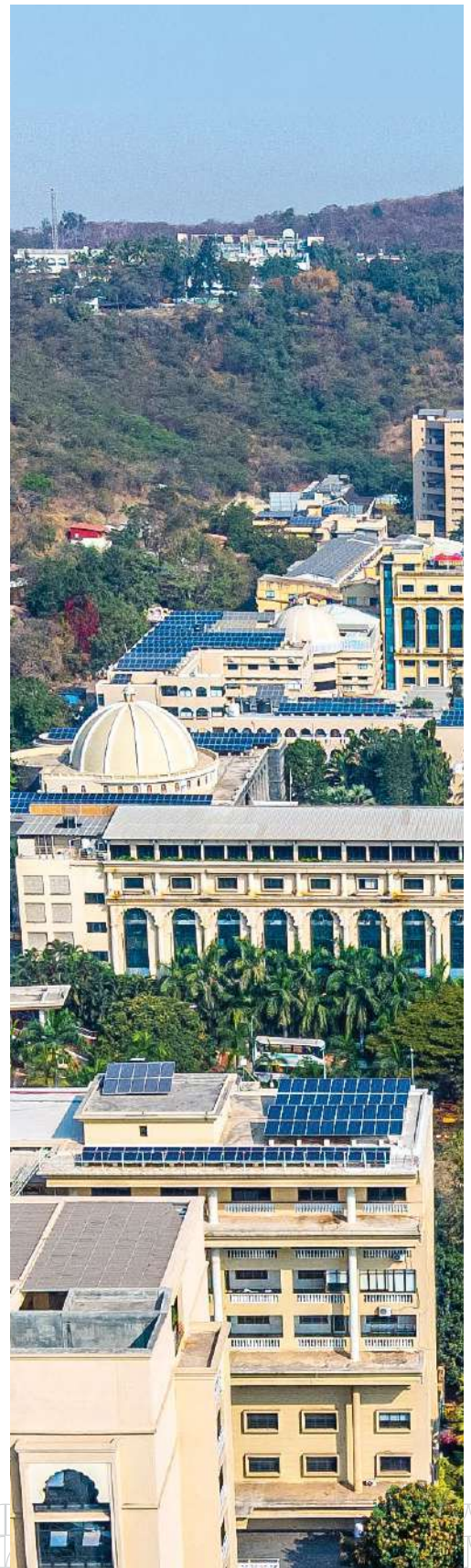

B) MIT-WPU Special Scholarship (First Cum First Serve Basis)

The first 10 admitted girl students and the first 10 admitted boy students who have secured a minimum of First Class in their 10th, 12th, and Graduation examinations shall be eligible for a 50% tuition fee waiver. Also, the next 10 admitted girl students and the next 10 admitted boy students who have secured a minimum of First Class in their Graduation examination and 55% in their 10th & 12th shall be eligible for a 20% tuition fee waiver.

In cases where a student is eligible for both the above tuition fee waiver and any MIT-WPU merit based scholarship, only the scholarship offering the higher financial benefit shall be awarded. The award of the above tuition fee waivers shall be strictly on a first-come, first-served basis.
