

# **BBA (Liberal Studies) Leadership**

## **Eligibility Criteria**

### **Maharashtra State (MS) Candidature**

1. Candidate should be an Indian National.
2. 50% in 10+2 / 12th / HSC Examination with English subject (OR)
3. 50% in Three Years Diploma Recognized by Government Competent Authority (OR)

Passed its equivalent examination with 50% Marks in aggregate (45% in case of Candidates of backward class categories and Persons with Disability belonging to Maharashtra State only)

### **Other Than Maharashtra (OMS) Candidature**

1. Candidate should be an Indian National.
2. 50% in 10+2 / 12th / HSC Examination with English subject (OR)
3. 50% in Three Years Engineering Diploma Recognized by Government Competent Authority (OR) passed its equivalent examination with 50% Marks in aggregate.

### **International**

- **Foreign Nationals / NRI / OCI / PIO, Children of Indian workers in the Gulf countries:**

50% in 10+2 / 12th / HSC Examination with English subject

**\* Direct admission will be provided to students applying under the International Category subject to eligibility criteria.**

- Application fees – Rs. 1000/-

### **Education details to capture -**

SSC (Year of passing / percentage / CGPA / Name of the board), HSC (Year of passing/ percentage/ CGPA / Name of the board)

**The final selection of a candidate will be based on the performance as per the Assessment Stages mentioned below:**

**Stage: I- Psychometric Assessment**

Personality test to evaluate the general attitude of students to gauge their inclination towards their area of interest.

**Stage: II- Statement of Purpose (50 marks)**

Statement of Purpose will test the communication skills, documentation skills and rationale of the candidate.

Post the successful completion of Stage I and Stage II,

**Stage: III-Group Discussion (50 marks)**

Group discussion will explore the critical thinking, analytical skills and knowledge of the students

**Selection Criteria****Note:**

1. \*12th/ 10+2/ Equivalent Exam Aggregate marks are considered only towards fulfillment of Eligibility and Scholarship criteria.
2. \*Prospective Students who successfully qualify the assessment will be offered provisional admission. Prospective Students can submit 12<sup>th</sup> Mark sheet and other eligibility documents as and when results are declared.
